Dear Rene:

I am submitting herewith a copy of the letter which I have written to the Société d'Electricité submitting my resignation as a member of the Board of Sodec. I am in the same letter requesting that my resignation as a member of the committee of the Cade, of which so far as I know I am still a member, be accepted.

In view of my inability to attend meetings of the Board of Sodec or of the committee of the Cade, I have for the last several months felt that I should present my resignation. As I cannot look forward to the possibility of attending meetings of either the Board of Sodec or of the committee of the Cade, I have for some time felt that I should submit my resignation. I would appreciate your seeing that this resignation is made effective at the next appropriate meeting of the Board of Sodec and by appropriate action so far as the Cade is concerned.

In the measure that it has been within my power I have endeavored to contribute in the past what I could, but it has been a pleasure and a satisfaction. The association has been a very pleasant one.
