I. PREFACE

This is the twenty-fifth edition of the Delaware Nursing Home Utilization Statistical Report. The report presents characteristics of Delaware's nursing homes and their patients. The data in this report does not include intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded (ICFMR). ICFMR facilities provide active treatment services to people with mental retardation and other related conditions causing adaptive behavior similar to that of the mentally retarded person which manifests before the person reaches the age of 22. Also, the report does not include data from facilities that serve the population under 18.

The Bureau of Health Planning & Resource Management has contracted with the University of Delaware's Center for Applied Demography & Survey Research to collect the data, provide data entry and verification services along with data tabulation and analysis.

The source of information for year 2012 encompassed in this document is monthly utilization statistical reports by Delaware nursing homes submitted to the University of Delaware's Center for Applied Demography & Survey Research. The center obtained a list of licensed nursing facilities at the beginning of the year from the Bureau of Health Planning & Resource Management. All changes to the list of licensed facilities, including name changes and changes in the number of licensed beds were communicated to the center by the bureau. Facilities were contacted on a monthly basis with requests sent the first day of the month. A combination of methods was used to contact the facilities on the list. The method was a combination of standard mail and e-mail, followed up by fax and phone. Using these methods, the center achieved full compliance from all facilities for all 12 months. When reports were received from individual facilities, the reports were checked for internal inconsistencies or unexpected changes in reported statistics. These discrepancies were immediately communicated back to the facilities with explanation and a request to update the data. Once an updated report was received by the center, the report was considered complete. All data collected was converted to an electronic format if not done so by the facility and then manually verified for consistency and accuracy. At the end of the reporting year, the data was recoded as needed and tabulated.

This report presents the collected data in two sections. The Facility Characteristics section of this report focuses on data from 2002 through 2012. Most of the summary presented here focuses on aggregated data for all nursing homes in Delaware, particularly:

- (1) Facility characteristics (number of homes and beds by ownership)
- (2) Utilization data (patient days, occupancy, admissions and discharges)
- (3) Patient characteristics (age, gender and source of payment)

The section entitled Tables presents summary characteristics such as total patient days, occupancy rate, and patients by source of payment, along with number of admissions and discharges for each facility.

Note:

Percentages in the report may not add up to 100% due to rounding.

When making year to year comparisons refer to Appendix A for changes in facility names and/or number of licensed beds.

STATE POPULATION

The growing size and the changing demographics of Delaware's population is central to the understanding of the distribution of nursing homes (and for that matter assisted living and rest residential facilities), the number of licensed nursing home beds and their utilization. To provide the context within which to evaluate the availability of facilities for the elderly, we are including two charts. The first chart presents the growing trend in the size of Delaware's total population. Chart two presents the growing number of those who are aged 65 and above. In both cases, significant increases are estimated. First, the estimates by the Delaware Population Consortium indicate a 22 percent jump in the total number of Delawareans from 2010 to 2040. The growth is distributed unevenly across counties. Sussex County's total population growth during this time period is estimated at 39.8 percent, with Kent County following at 23.8 percent and New Castle County following at 14.9 percent. Looking at the total number of Delawareans aged 65 and above, the change is even more dramatic. Based on the numbers from the Delaware Population Consortium, it is estimated that the population of Delawareans aged 65 and above will grow 99% (103,301 to 258,905) from 2010 to 2040.

II. FACILITY CHARACTERISTICS

NUMBER OF NURSING HOME BEDS

The number of nursing homes in Delaware increased to 47 in 2012. In addition, there was an increase of the number of licensed beds from 4,986 in 2011 to 5,081 in 2012. This increase accounted for a 1.9 percent increase in the total number of licensed beds from 2011 to 2012. One facility (Delaware Veterans Home) moved from being considered a private facility to a public facility in 2012. Of the total beds, approximately 85 percent were privately owned in 2012. Correspondingly, the percentage of beds in public facilities increased to 15 percent with the addition of Delaware Veterans Home in 2012.



UTILIZATION

For private and public facilities together, the number of patient days increased by 0.1 percent between 2011 and 2012. The number of patient days in private facilities decreased by 1.6 percent. Looking at private facilities by county, the growth was unevenly distributed - there was a 1.6 percent increase in New Castle County, a 19 percent decrease in Kent (due to the moving of Delaware Veterans Home) and a 1.3 percent increase in Sussex County. The public facilities experienced an increase of 18.5 percent from 2011 to 2012 of which can be credited to the addition of another facility.

OCCUPANCY

Between 2011 and 2012, the overall occupancy rate for all facilities combined decreased 1.8 percent from 86.8 percent to 85.2 percent. Private facilities' occupancy rate in New Castle County increased from 90.3 percent to 90.4 percent (0.1 percent increase). The occupancy rate for private facilities in Kent County decreased from 93.6 percent to 93.3 percent (0.3 percent decrease). The occupancy rate for private facilities in Sussex County decreased from 88.5 percent to 87.5 percent (1.1 percent decrease). The occupancy rate for public facilities across the state decreased from 61.0 percent to 57.7 percent (5.4 percent decrease).

^{*} The occupancy rate for year 2012 presented here is identical with the weighted occupancy rate based on actual number of days facility was open, see Table 2 in Section III. Please note that facilities closing or changes in the number of licensed beds can influence the above occupancy rates. For details on these changes please see Appendix A.

ADMISSIONS

Between 2011 and 2012, the number of admissions among all facilities in Delaware increased 0.6 percent. Admissions to private facilities increased by 0.6 percent while admissions to public facilities decreased 1.5 percent between 2011 and 2012. Comparing admissions from a decade ago, the number of admissions combined for all facilities increased by about 62.4 percent (which is a decrease of the 66.8 percent in from 2001 to 2011). Admissions at public facilities declined 37.9 percent (up from the 2001 to 2011 decrease of 52.9 percent), while admissions at private facilities grew by about 63.8 percent (down from the 2001 to 2011 increase of 69.2 percent).

The percent of patients admitted to Delaware nursing homes by race within specific age groups is presented in the figure below. About 11.8 percent of whites admitted to Delaware's nursing homes in 2012 were under age 65, while about 25.3 percent of blacks admitted to nursing home are in this age group. Clearly, the age of patient admission to nursing homes in Delaware varies by race. Blacks tend to enter nursing homes in Delaware at a younger age than whites. Of the black admissions in 2012, 49.9 percent were less than 75 years of age, compared to 30.5 percent for whites.

Although blacks are admitted to Delaware nursing homes at a younger age, the percent of black admissions (from all admissions) is lower than white admissions in all age groups as indicated in the figure below. This figure shows the percent of all patients admitted to Delaware nursing homes in the year 2012 by race and age. From all admissions to Delaware nursing homes, only 8.7 percent were black and 75 or under while more than double that (24.6 percent) are whites in the same age category.

DISCHARGES

The number of patients discharged from nursing homes across Delaware increased from 11,457 in 2011 to 11,535 in 2012 (0.7 percent increase). The number of patients discharged from private facilities increased 0.6 percent (from 11,354 in 2011 to 11,419 in 2012) and the number of patients discharged from public facilities increased 12.6 percent (from 103 in 2011 to 116 in 2012). The change in the number of discharges between 2011 and 2012 from private facilities varies across the counties. Discharges from private facilities in New Castle County increased by 0.9 percent, in Kent County increased by 7.1 percent, and in Sussex County decreased by 2.7 percent. Looking at the data historically, there was a 59.5 percent increase in discharges from 2002 to 2012.

The proportion of patients discharged to different destinations varies by the type of facility. For example, patients in public facilities are less likely to be discharged to home (12.9 percent from public and 54.0 percent from private) or hospital (11.2 percent from public, 28.1 percent from private) and more likely to be discharged due to death (63.8 percent from public, 10.6 percent from private) than their counterparts in private facilities.

The percent of patients discharged from Delaware's nursing homes by race within specific age groups is presented in the figure below. About 11.5 percent of whites discharged from Delaware's nursing homes are under age 65, while 25.1 percent of blacks discharged are in this age group. Clearly, the age of patients discharged from nursing homes in Delaware varies by race. Blacks tend to be discharged from nursing homes in Delaware at a younger age than whites. Of the black discharges in 2012, 48.0 percent were less than 75 years of age, compared to 30.0 percent for whites.

From all discharges, only 8.2 percent were black and less than 75 years of age while more than double (24.3 percent) are whites in the same age category.

SOURCES OF PAYMENT


The source of payment for nursing home care varies by type of facility. In private facilities, approximately 55 percent of the residents had Medicaid as the source of payment, while 73 percent of patients in public nursing homes paid by Medicaid in 2012. About 21 percent of patients in private facilities were self-pay in 2012, while 18 percent of patients in public facilities were self-pay. Medicare is not a major payer of nursing home care. In 2012, Medicare was the source of payment for 17 percent of all patients. In private facilities, about 19 percent of patients were paid by Medicare, and in public facilities one percent paid by Medicare. However, the percent of Medicare patients has increased since 2002 when the percentage of patients with Medicare as a source of payment stood at 10.6 percent.

The chart below tabulates the estimates of Medicaid patient days for Delaware's public and private facilities for the period of 2002 to 2012. Please note that the counts of Medicaid days are based on end of month reporting. To estimate the patient days, it was assumed that those who were reported to be at the facility at the end of the month were also there for the whole month. This assumption very likely overstates the number of Medicaid patient days. However, the expectation is that the assumption does not impact the magnitude of the difference between private and public facilities.
