

Recrology

Delaware Notes includes no systematic necrology. However, it is fitting to record in this issue the greatest loss by death which the University has ever suffered in so short a period. During the present year, within the space of less than two months, three notable friends and officers of the University have passed away: on February 28, Harry Fletcher Brown of Wilmington, a trustee of the University and a generous benefactor; on February 29, George Elliott Dutton, a graduate of Delaware College in 1904, a member of the Department of English since 1911, and Dean of Delaware College from 1923; and on April 14, Walter Hullihen, President of the University from 1920.
