Newark Election Board Chairman Announces Final Tally With Local Reregistration For Six-District Program; 760 Voters Register On Last Two Of 10 Days Scheduled

Harold M. Grant, chairman of the Newark Election Board, reports a total of 3,596 persons registered to vote in municipal election to be held April 10 for the selection of mayor, and one council representative from each of three districts—the third, fifth, and sixth districts.


