Dear Dannie:

I have just had a letter from Bill Arnold in Buenos Aires written I think just before he was leaving on a trip north, and I thought the letter was sufficiently interesting to send you a copy, which I enclose herewith, as well as a copy of my reply. I gather from Bill's letter that he is planning to be in New York during the month of August and while I do not know where he will be staying with his wife, he can be reached through the Squibb Company at 745 Fifth Avenue. I am sure he will be glad to see you and I think it will be interesting for you to talk the Buenos Aires general situation over with him. I suggested to Nat Samuels, who is here, that if you should not happen to be in New York that he can see Arnold, but I think it would be very nice for Nat to meet him too.

Nat will be leaving tomorrow or day after, depending upon when he can get a plane and you will undoubtedly be seeing him by the time you get this letter. I wish that he could stay longer, for his stay here will have been so short, but I understand that you want him to come back. In any event, he will have a good idea of what Mexico City is like. I am happy to have had the chance to see Nat here and talk things over with him.

I still do not have any report from the doctor as the examinations are not finished, but from what I can gather, all the examinations have turned out all right, and they have not found anything really important wrong. Since last Saturday I am feeling a great deal better. I was really getting concerned, because the pains in my abdomen were getting more frequent and really annoying, and in the last two months I have lost about 14 pounds, some of which I could afford to lose and some not. I am feeling a lot better really and I am not losing any more weight.
