Besides deciding whether research will be their niche, seniors can use the undergraduate research program to

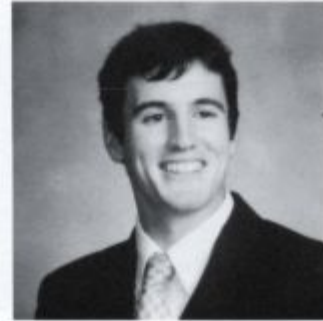

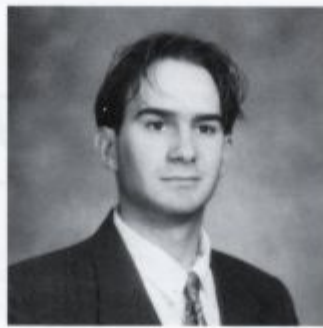
Many seniors had very few problems at checkout, and focused more on the experience itself — on seeing their entire
