This is just a word to tell you that I am not able as yet to state when I will be able to leave. It was my hope to be able to leave at the latest by the end of this week for a Board meeting in New York and to see the World Bank and to remain around New York for a few days and then go to a Board meeting in Toronto on June 29 and our Annual Meeting in Toronto of the shareholders on June 30. I have not been able to make any definite plans for leaving, as there are certain arrangements with the Mexican authorities which we must complete in definite form before I leave here, and as I now see it I will not be able to leave here before the middle of next week, that is, around June 17 or 18, or perhaps as late as the end of that week. When I can make definite plans I will let you know by telegram in Toledo or try to telephone you from here.
