Professor Monk,

The Sport Management program, which is currently housed in the Department of Health, Nutrition, and Exercise Sciences, will likely be transferring to the Department of Business Administration in the Lerner College of Business & Economics on July 1, 2010. In preparation for the transfer, we are revising the curriculum so that the core courses conform to those required by all other majors in the Lerner College.

Under the proposed curriculum, Sport Management students would be required to take Math 201, 202, and 221. Students currently matriculated into the Sport Management program will have the option of completing the requirements for the old or the new curriculum. Probably half of the existing students have already completed a math course required for the old curriculum, and perhaps half of the remaining students will choose to complete the old curriculum. Given that there are about 100 majors, I would expect that these changes might require up to 25 additional seats in Math 201/202/221 for the 2010-2011 academic year (and 25 fewer seats for the math course(s) the students were currently taking, which I cannot identify based on the existing program of study). More seats would be required in future years, but this depends on how enrollments for the Sport Management program are affected by the more rigorous core requirements.

If you support these changes, could you respond with an e-mail that I can include as part of the support materials for the program approval form?

Please let me know if you have any questions. The proposed program of study is attached to this email.
