Dear friend:

I am unexpectedly making a brief trip to Belgium. My wife wants to go to Antwerp to buy some dresses and as I have to go to Cologne we are going to drive to Cologne on Wednesday. I will be in Cologne at the Consulate on Thursday until 4 o'clock when I leave for Liege where we will spend Thursday evening at the Hotel de Suede. Max Horn heard from his cousin in Antwerp that I might be coming up and I have a letter from him asking me to lunch with him. I have therefore written him that we will lunch with him on Friday and I am sending you herewith a copy of my letter to him. I had promised him the last time I saw him here, that when I came to Brussels I would lunch with him.
