

Dear friend:



I am unexpectedly making a brief trip to Belgium. My wife wants to go to Antwerp to buy some dresses and as I have to go to Cologne we are going to drive to Cologne on Wednesday. I will be in Cologne at the Consulate on Thursday until 4 o'clock when I leave for Liege where we will spend Thursday evening at the Hotel de Suede.
