Dear Dannie:

I had a telegram from President Peron acknowledging our Christmas card and I thought you might be interested in seeing a copy. All of my friends who have recently been in the Argentine tell me that Peron always makes it a point of speaking about me and that when my name comes up he always has many nice things to say. When General Edgerton and Henry Holland were in the Argentine recently Peron took occasion to speak very kindly about me, etc. I think he is really hoping to get some things done which seem to be in the right direction and I think this very nice telegram is an indication that he hopes I will maintain my interest in him and his country, which of course I am doing, and I have been trying to be helpful in connection with Argentine matters in any way that I properly can during the last year.

Sometime ago I wrote a letter to President Eisenhower at the suggestion of Foster Dulles with regard to various things and as of possible interest to you I am sending you herewith a copy of the acknowledgement of the letter from Foster and also Sherman Adams' acknowledgement of the letter to the President. I have directly reasons to know that my letter to the President was found very helpful by him.

Please do not bother to acknowledge this note and the enclosures. I will shortly be writing just a purely personal note to President Peron and will send you a copy when I do so. With all the best from Marion and myself and affectionate greetings to the whole family,
