essential lighting in City Hall during that period. The city has undertaken energy conservation measures that include use of motion detectors that activate and turn off lights.

Residents and businesses are also asked to do their part and extinguish as many lights as possible. The event will come at the end of the city's

downtown Wine and Dine that will allow participants to sample vintages and dishes in downtown. Fruehstorfer said safety remains the top issue, but suggested businesses, such as restaurants, could look for ways to reduce lighting during that period.

Earth Hour has been gaining momentum in the U.S., with the Las Vegas Strip and the Empire State Building going dark during the 60 minutes.

The council received an ordinance that would allow more students to be housed in homes along Continental Avenue. The ordinance will receive final consideration at a future meeting.

Council members also encouraged residents to fill out their U.S. Census forms. That includes students who do not believe they need to fill out forms.

Also discussed was the possibility of moving the start time

of the City Council meeting from 7:30 p.m. to 7 p.m.

City Hall watchdog Jean White said the earlier time might not allow enough time for dinner prior to the meeting and reduce the amount of time spent with the family.

City Manager Kyle Sonnenberg said the 7 p.m. time would not necessarily reduce costs for the city. Rather, it is the actual length of the meeting, he said.

That resulted in a discussion on possible ways to make meetings more efficient.

Later in the meeting, the

discussion turned to the format of a Council Workshop, scheduled for April 12th.

Workshops are designed to discuss weighty issues, such as city budgets. Council members opted to keep comments made by the public at the end of the meeting, rather than during discussion of individual agenda items.

Newark, like most municipalities, is dealing with revenue shortfalls, due to a sluggish economy and tough real estate markets, leading to more extensive use of workshops to hash out issues.

# Newark Police investigating rape in Chapel Street area

Newark Police detectives are investigating a sexual assault that occurred off North Chapel Street.

A 21 year-old female victim reports, that on March 14th, she had been celebrating her birthday at two Main Street restaurants. At approximately 11:30 p.m., she was walking alone on North Chapel Street, when an

unknown male picked her up, threw her over his shoulder and carried her into a house.

The suspect carried her to a second floor bedroom and raped her. After the assault, the victim grabbed her clothes and ran from the house.

## Items taken from cars

Newark Police reported that on March 15th, unknown suspects removed two iPods and a GPS from a car parked on

McKean Place. On March 16th, unknown suspects removed a GPS and an MP3 Player from a car parked on East Main Street. Police agencies throughout the region have been reminding residents to not leave items of value in plain view in vehicles.

## Drugs found on sleeping man

On March 16th, at 8:22 p.m., Newark officers went to the East Delaware Avenue DART Transit Hub, after receiving a

report of a subject who would not exit the bus. Upon arriving at the scene, officers observed a Newark resident who appeared to be sleeping. Attempts to wake the suspect were unsuccessful. During the course of the investigation officers discovered the suspect had marijuana, heroin, and other illegal narcotics on his person. The suspect was charged with possession of the drugs and possession of controlled substance within 1,000 feet of a school.

## Teen arrested in failed theft attempt

New Castle County Police have arrested a 16 year-old Hockessin male who attempted to steal a "heavy hauler trailer" from a home on Old Cooches Bridge Road, just south of Newark.

Early on the morning of

March 22nd, County Police went to a home in the 1900 block of Old Cooches Bridge Road for a report of a theft in progress. The 82 year-old male victim reported he was startled by the sound of a pickup truck in his driveway and looked outside to see the vehicle and a subject attempting to steal his "heavy hauler trailer" from his rear yard.

While driving off, the suspect's vehicle caused significant damage to the victim's lawn and underground propane tank. Evidently, the suspect was having difficulty pulling the trailer so the suspect got out of the truck and left it behind.

Several officers went to the scene as witnesses reported seeing the suspect vehicle traveling in an erratic manner on Chesapeake City Road. Senior Sergeant Stephen DiVirgilio located the suspect's vehicle in a farmer's field near the Maryland

state line. The driver, who was wearing a hooded sweatshirt, mask and had spray painted his face, was taken into custody.

The teen has been charged with felony attempted theft, criminal mischief, driving without a license, malicious mischief by a motor vehicle, and criminal trespassing in the 3rd degree. He has been arraigned and taken to the New Castle County Detention Center after failing to post \$2,000 secured bail.

## Tip, search lead to murder suspects

Cecil County officers say an anonymous tip and the search of an Elkton-area apartment played pivotal roles in this week's arrest of the two remaining suspects in the 2009 murder of a Newark area woman near Chesapeake City, Md.

According to Lt. Bernard Chiominto of the Cecil County Sheriff's Office, investigators recovered evidence while searching a West Creek Village apartment that helped them track down 20-year-old Joel Thomas Milburn of Elk Mills and 17-year-old Seth Dallas Jedlicka of Middletown, who both were captured by U.S. marshals at a motel in Miami early last week.

Chiominto said investigators searched the apartment of Milburn's ex-girlfriend on March 5 after receiving an anonymous tip.

"We were told that fruits of the crime might be inside that residence," he said. "We didn't find any stolen property, but we did find correspondences from

Spring, it is around the corner, and am I ever ready for it, as I am sure we all are. There are still the lingering piles of snow on the ground, but the warmer weather that has graced us this past week has brought on spring fever with a vengeance.

Spring, it is a time of birth, preparation and growth. Lambing and calving seasons have begun and farmers have begun to prepare their fields for the season ahead. You'll start to hear the familiar whir of the tractor engine or see farming implements traveling down the road in efforts to prepare fields.

Maybe you have a pile of gardening catalogs that await your perusal or perhaps you have a detailed outline of what your plans are for your own garden plot. For the last few

years, community gardening was in resurgence, and it looks like this is going to continue. Maybe this year will be your year to become a member of a community garden. Maybe you are excited for your first taste of locally produced strawberries or tomatoes, or to receive your first share of your subscription to the Community Supported Agriculture operation you joined. Or, perhaps you're excited to take your family for a visit to a local farm and experience an agri-tourism adventure.

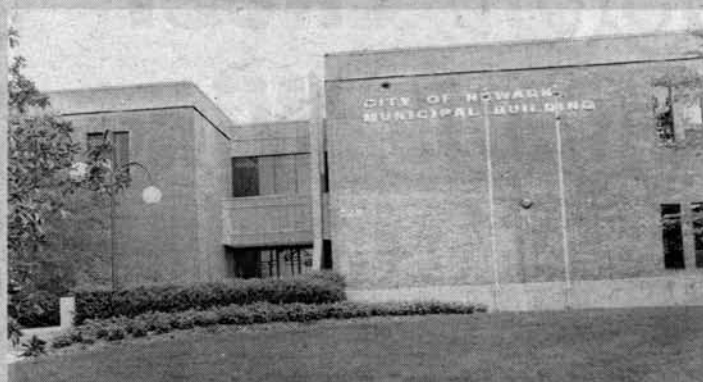
Our state's farmers' markets will be opening in June and are a place to go and find an eclectic mix of the best Delaware has to offer. While you still have awhile to go for traditionally produced fresh fruits and vegetables in Delaware, you do have an opportunity to enjoy locally grown foods and support local businesses. Several local restaurants have partnered with area growers for supply of meats and to a lesser extent at this time of year - produce. We have several growers who produce hydroponic vegetables and use

high tunnels and the like as season extenders. Maybe you thought ahead and were able to stock up and either freeze or can some farm fresh veggies from last season. Perhaps your freezer and cupboards are growing bare. Plan ahead this year. If you do not have a garden, purchase extra locally grown produce and process it yourself at home either through canning or freezing. You will literally enjoy the fruits of your labor throughout the season. It has been my experience, if you process commodities properly and use a great recipe, you sacrifice little in flavor.

There is nothing like enjoying fare that is home grown or produced locally. There are plenty of opportunities to experience our State's number one industry agriculture - whether you bring it to your own back yard or support our local farmers.

## OUT OF THE ATTIC

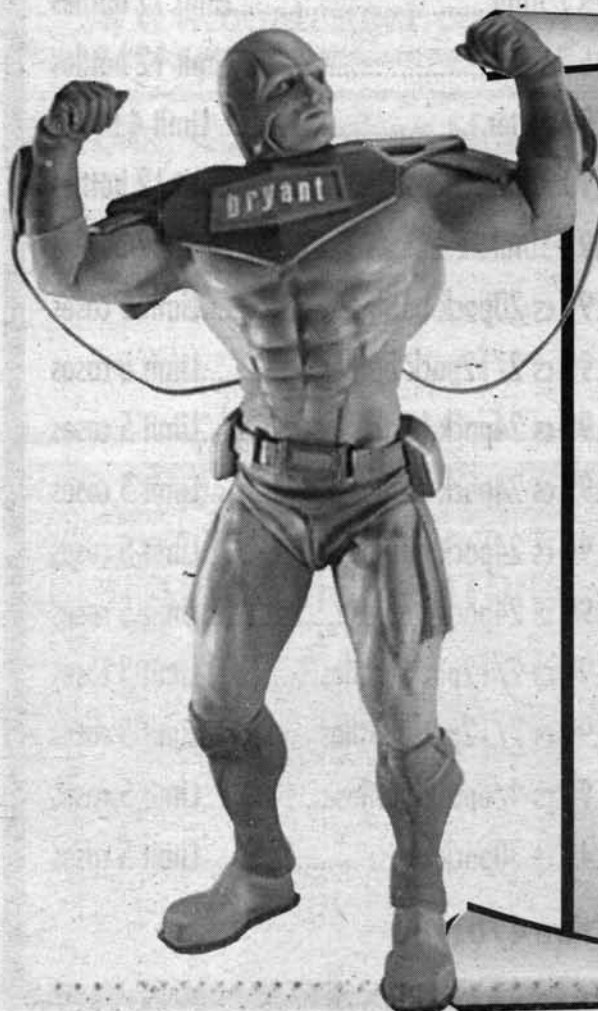


This week's Out of the Attic item is an undated early picture of the Newark Municipal Building completed in 1975 at 220 Elkton Road. The building brought together the management and operating offices of the city government. It features a large meeting room for City Council and other public boards and committees. A later addition brought the separately located Police Department and Alderman's Court to the site. The Town Office for many years was in the original one bay Aetna fire house on Academy Street. The office moved to larger space in the Academy Building across the street. Continuing growth of the town and the City staff needed to provide services to

the community led to the present custom designed facility on Elkton Road.

The picture is on loan to the Newark Post from the Newark Historical Society collection. Visit the Newark History exhibits at the Newark Free Library and the Municipal Building. 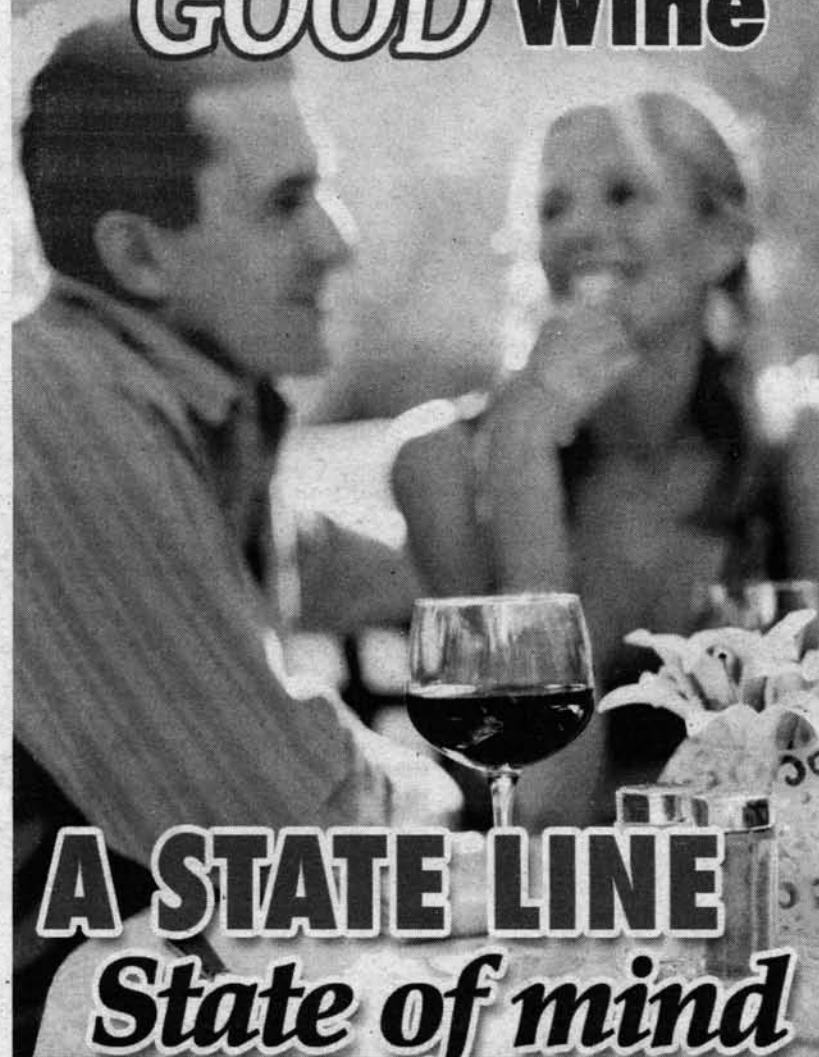

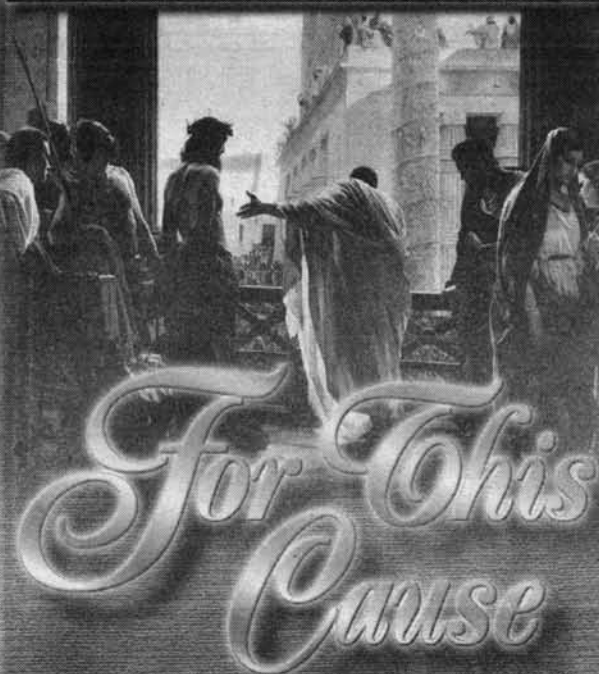

## Newark resident Thomson receives honor

The year was 1938 ... Bill Thomson's mother loaded him in the car and together they took the 30-minute trip from Swarthmore to Philadelphia to see the Penn Relays Carnival. The enormity and glamour of the nation's oldest track and field meet cast an immediate spell on the naïve young boy, and from that moment on the Newark resident was hooked on the sport.

"I was enthralled by it," Thomson said in a phone interview shortly after returning from his annual three-month winter hiatus in Florida. "I was so spell-bound that I still remember most of the winners from that day."

That trip to Franklin Field on the University of Pennsylvania campus was just the beginning of the Newark resident's long and storied career in track and field, one that has included coaching and officiating at the sport's highest levels.

And now, even at 82, like the Energizer Bunny on those battery commercials, Thomson keeps on going ... and going ... and going.

Thomson's years of service to the Delaware track and field community will be recognized on March 25 when he receives the Herm Reitzes Award, which recognizes long-time service to athletes in Delaware, at the annual Delaware Sportswriters & Broadcasters Association Banquet at Cavaliers Country

Club.

"I was surprised when I was notified about the award," Thomson said. "I asked to make sure it wasn't being given to me as a 'has-been,' and they assured me it wasn't."

Thomson's accomplishments as a track and field official include serving as the Penn Relays' high school referee, overseeing the competition involving over 11,000 athletes. He has also refereed virtually every major NCAA and national event. But Thomson doesn't let what many would consider a haughty status keep him from doing what he perhaps loves most, serving as a referee here locally at the New Castle County and state high school championships.

"There's no one better on

rules in the United States," says Jim Fischer, director of running programs at the University of Delaware. "He's as big as there is in high schools across the nation. He's active on a national scale in rules and coaching."

Thomson is also an international-level coach whose lengthy resume includes serving as hurdles coach on the 1980 USA Olympic women's team that boycotted the Moscow Games. His well-known coaching expertise helped put Delaware on the national track and field map and eventually led to his induction into the Delaware Track and Field Hall of Fame (1994) and the Delaware Sports Hall of Fame (1997).

"He and Jimmy Flynn started the women's track program here at UD," Fischer added. "And to this day, he and his (Thomson's) wife, Ann, remain very supportive of our program. Bill has been a wonderful mentor to me."

Thomson and his wife of 59 years, who is also a track and field official, passed on their passion for the sport to their five children.

"Track has always been a part of the DNA in our family," says son Gordon Thomson, who ran at Newark High and the University of Florida. "I grew up in the bowels of Franklin Field at the Penn Relays. It was like being in a castle."

Gordon says of all his father's accomplishments and awards, this one in particular will be very special to him.

"He's an avid newspaper reader, so to be honored by a group of sportswriters ... well it will just make this award even more special to him."

Thomson says he has kept plenty busy the last couple weeks since his return from Florida, but added he's already looking forward to his first meet of the season, April 10, at the University of Delaware.

"I've always felt an obligation to the sport. I made a pact to myself a long time ago that I would try to serve as a role model to the younger coaches and officials. And as long as I feel I can contribute, I will."

Fortunately for thousands of track and field participants in the state of Delaware and all over the country, Bill Thomson just keeps on going ... and going ... and going.

High alum David Zartler, led Goldey-Beacom to a new school record and overall fifth-place finish in both the sprint medley relay (1:43.36) and the distance medley relay (12:12.92) last Saturday at Richard Stockton College.

Frantz was named Goldey-Beacom's athlete of the week for his performances this past weekend, which also included setting a school record in the 100-meter dash with a time of 12.07 seconds.

"Mike has raised that bar this off season by putting in a lot of training and this was the verification that it was all worth it," head coach Brian Conley said. "He works very hard at practice and I expect him to run below 12 seconds before the season is over."

Milburn and Jedlicka while they were on the run."

Chiominto declined to name the woman who rents the apartment or specify the type of correspondence they recovered.

He did note, however, that Jedlicka's mother and his two adult sisters were at the apartment when police served the search warrant. He described all four women as "uncooperative."

Jedlicka's mother also is accused of hiding the vehicle used in the November robbery and murder. Although she has not been charged with any crimes, police said they recovered the white 1998 Plymouth Breeze that Jedlicka and Milburn were thought to still be using, hidden in a garage at her Middletown home.

"We believe that (Milburn and Jedlicka) were assisted while on the run, and those people who helped them will be arrested and charged," he said.

Their alleged accomplices, 17-year-old Anthony Michael Melchor and 21-year-old Karl Gladden-Postles, both of Elkton, have been in custody since Feb. 26.

All four men are charged in

the shooting death of 40-year-old Newark-area resident Terri Ann McCoy on Nov. 4. As-yet-unidentified property reportedly valued at more than \$100,000 was taken during the home invasion robbery and murder at McCoy's parents home in the 3700 block of Augustine Herman Highway.

Each of the suspects is facing an assortment of felony charges, including first-degree murder, armed robbery and first-degree burglary.

Chiominto said police began to receive tips about the crime almost immediately and the amount of volunteered information only increased after Melchor and Gladden-Postles were arrested last month.

"We believe that Milburn and Jedlicka had remained in this area until we arrested the first two suspects," he said. "That's when they went on the run."

"There is no honor among thieves," he quipped. "Evidently, even (criminals) believe what the suspects did was uncalled for." The two men are now in Maryland.

are currently investigating a reported armed robbery that occurred over the weekend in the Harbor Club Apartments in the Ogletown area. On March 20 at 3:55 p.m., County Police responded to the 10 Cheswold Blvd. apartment 1D for a report of an armed robbery. The female victim had gone to the Cheswold Blvd. address to deliver a pizza order.

When she knocked on the door, a male emerged from the laundry room and produced a large black revolver. The subject pointed the weapon at the victim and robbed her of an undisclosed amount of cash before forcing her into a nearby "electrical room." The suspect then fled the area.

He is described as a dark skinned, unshaven black male with a thin build and about 5'11". He was last seen wearing a dark colored shirt, blue jeans, and a tan "boonie" hat. Police later learned the apartment, where the food was to be delivered, was not occupied. 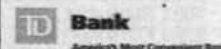

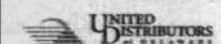
