Chapman wins District 5 election

Newark's District 5 residents elected Luke Chapman as their new City Council representative during Tuesday's election.

Chapman, 28, a financial planner from Fairfield Crest, received 266 votes, while his opponent, Rick Celeste, a systems engineer who lives in Fairfield, had 96 votes.

Chapman will be sworn in during a public session on Tuesday, April 17, at council chambers on Elkton Road.

District 5 represents the north-

western part of the city, including the neighborhoods of Fairfield, West Branch and Christianstead.

Chapman will fill the seat previously held by Ezra Temko, who announced earlier this year that he would not seek a third term. Chapman said Wednesday that his first order of business is simply to get acclimated to his new position.

"I don't have any particular pet projects lined up; it's really just a matter of finding that balance and getting acclimated," he said. "We have a wonderful city with a very good sense of community. More or less, everyone is happy to live in Newark, so my biggest

concern will be maintaining the lifestyle and quality of life that people already have here, helping us become more efficient and bringing us into the future."

Chapman said his parents are both entrepreneurs, which helped instill in him a sense of creativity and community spirit. A Newark resident for the past 15 years, he lives in Fairfield Crest with his wife, Meredith, and their dog, Indy.

Ed Smith IV, a third candidate for the council seat, dropped out of the race unexpectedly last week.

A perfect match

Newark woman will give brother a kidney during transplant Monday

Monday, April 16 will be the first day of the rest of Chris Hatfield's life.

That morning, Hatfield, 34, of Chesapeake City, will head to Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, where doctors will remove a kidney from his 32-year-old sister, Alison

McCall of Newark, and transplant it into Hatfield's pelvis, in an operation Hatfield says will be one of the greatest turning points in his life.

This will be the second kidney transplant for Hatfield, who developed a tumor on one of his kidneys when he was a toddler and had to have the kidney removed. Then as a teenager, he developed IGA

Nephropathy, an autoimmune condition that caused his other kidney to fail.

In 1999, when he was 18 years old, Hatfield received his first transplant; his mother, Deb Sperco, was his donor.

Sperco's kidney was not a perfect match — tests of his close fam-

citing personal reasons.

On Wednesday morning, Celeste said he was relieved the election was over and happy that the race never got "dirty."

"Luke and I made a pact with (Smith) long ago that we would not get down and dirty during this race, and we didn't," Celeste said. "It was a very cordial election (but) it's been so tiring, working full-time and

trying to run a campaign, which is a lot of work to begin with. Luke persevered, and when we got the results last night, I said, 'Luke, if you want me to come up and say a few words for you, you got it,

pal.' I felt we should come out of this with a great relationship, and we did."

Celeste said he plans to continue working as a consultant to city officials on local projects, including three skate parks still in the

planning stages.

"I'm gonna stay involved in the city; I'm not going anywhere," he said. "I'm not gonna be involved as much as I might have been (had I won the election) – but I have Luke for that now," he

said, laughing.

Councilmen Doug Tuttle and Stu Markham ran unopposed for their seats on the council.

Kidney donor is ready to be pampered

ily members revealed that his sister Alison's actually was — but doctors decided to give him Sperco's kidney, so McCall's could be a backup option if something went wrong with the procedure or the donated kidney eventually failed.

After living with his mother's donated kidney for about seven years, Hatfield's health did start going sour in 2007. In 2010, he started dialysis treatments, and preparation for another transplant — this time with the kidney from his sister — got underway.

Five days a week, he has to be hooked up to a dialysis machine that cleans his blood and basically serves the function of the kidneys.

He is lucky in that, instead of having to go to a health clinic to have the dialysis, he qualified to have the machine in his home.

"It sucks the blood out and it's like a shampoo; it cleans the blood out like a kidney would," Hatfield said. "It does it three hours a day, five days a week."

The state of his well-being at this point is pretty miserable.

"I feel half-dead, to be honest with you," he said.

His fiancé, Jamie Forbes, 32, has been taking care of him and helps get him hooked up to the dialysis machine every evening.

"She's my nurse, she's been my caretaker for about a year," he said. "I just can't wait for this transplant; she's been sacrificing everything since I got sick."

Hatfield has been unable to work since the kidney from his mother went bad.

He and Forbes, who have a 5-year-old son together and two girls, ages 9 and 12, from previous relationships, became engaged on Valentine's Day of 2008. Hatfield became ill not long after they got engaged, so the couple have postponed their wedding. Forbes said they plan to get married as soon as Hatfield gets his health back.

"It like the past two years I've been in hiding," Hatfield said. "But I honestly believe that when I get this transplant, life will resume. (Right now,) the kids want me to play and I can't. I can't run with my son; he's 4 and he wants me to go out there and

play football with him and I can't do that. The difference between dialysis and actually receiving that kidney is — I can't put it into words. It's amazing after you get the transplant, the blood rushes to the kidney immediately. It's like the breath is back, the life is back."

ALWAYS ON CALL

McCall says that ever since her brother's first transplant in 1999, she's known that she might be called upon to donate one of her kidneys to him.

"I'm a 6 out of 6 for Chris as far as being a donor; our tissue typing is like we're twins," McCall said. "I was 20 when I found out that I might have to be a donor and I've always known; it was just like, whenever the time came, as long as I didn't have kidney stones, I would be the donor. Other family members got (kidney stones) and I never have, knock on wood."

She said she was mildly concerned that the surgery might leave an unsightly scar and "I worried about how I might look in a bathing suit." Doctors assured her that any bikini would

hide the scar from surgery.

Other than that, she said, "There was no hesitation on my part. We're going to Hopkins and you couldn't ask for a better hospital."

Last week, among preparatory bloodwork and doctors' appointments, McCall said she's mentally prepared for the surgery.

"I'm excited to get it over with, because he needs it," she said. "A year is a long time and his health is getting worse, so my thought is, let's just get it over with so he can get back to normal," she said. "The dialysis is rough (on the body). He's got kids, and — say for instance, on July Fourth, we were all barbecuing and my sister plays this corn-hole game we always like to play; it's really fun, but (Chris) could only play two rounds and then he had to go in the house and lay down. So it will be nice for him to get his energy back."

Estimated recovery times for each of the siblings' surgeries is about one month. McCall said she is looking forward to a little pampering. Her mom, who lives in New Jersey, will be staying with her in Newark for a



couple of weeks, and she's hoping the rest of the family will kick in, too.

"I take care of three kids and a husband, so I'm waiting for the roles to reverse," she joked. "I'm just hoping someone will get me a bell."

Getting into the swing of a new sport takes time

Saturday is opening day for youth baseball and softball organizations in the Newark/Bear area, and

many kids will take the field in a brand-new uniform for the first time ever.

For some, it's the start of a youth sports "career" that could span several years and several different sports.

For others, it might be the only season they ever get to play. But regardless of which category a child is in, we parents should remember that it's a first-time experience that should


be enjoyed ... by everyone.

Playing a sport for the first time is no different than that first day of school or daycare, and it can be tough – for the child and the parent – to cut that cord. And in this day and age, children often play organized sports before going off to school, so it literally is the first time in their young lives when they are supervised and instructed by someone other than Mom or Dad.

If your child seems to be having trouble adjusting (translation: listening) to his or her new coach, remember, it's a whole new experience, just like that first day of school. A good coach already expects this before the umpire bellows out "Play ball," so there's no need to think your child is going to lose playing time if he isn't listening to every word.

It's also perfectly normal for your child to daydream in the field, watch a plane go by overhead or chase a butterfly. I'd actually be more concerned if a blaring fire truck went by and he didn't look. After all, don't you?

And asking, "What's for snack?" before the first

inning is over is also perfectly normal, as is wanting

to go visit the Port-a-John after a teammate comes back and can't stop talking about what he saw or smelled during his trip there.

Remember, for this first game especially, your child is going to be more consumed with everything going on around him than how far he hits the ball, if he makes a great catch or what his coach has to say.

As much as we don't want our kids to grow up too fast, sometimes we expect them to do just that. We think that just because it's a sport, there shouldn't be an adjustment period or a learning curve. But there is going to be one.

Often during that first season in a youth sport, learning to catch and throw are the easy parts. For the child, it's harder to learn how to listen and follow directions since he's only used to doing so at home or in school. And for us parents, it's sometimes hard to be patient. A child that smacked balls all over

Trout season open in six New Castle County streams

Delaware's spring 2012 upstate trout season opened Saturday at six designated trout streams in northern New Castle County: White Clay Creek, Christina Creek, Pike Creek, Beaver Run, Wilson Run and Mill Creek. The streams are stocked and ready with thousands of rainbow and brown trout, including some trophy-sized fish. Trout stocking will continue weekly through the first week in May.

Anglers wishing to try their luck should remember that in addition to Delaware's normal fishing-


license requirements, most anglers also must purchase a trout stamp, which costs \$4.20 for ages 16 through 64, or a youth stamp, which costs \$2.10 for youth anglers ages 12 through 15.

A resident annual fishing license, which now covers fresh and tidal waters as well as crabbing and clamming, costs \$8.50 for ages 16 through 64. Persons under age 16 and residents age 65 and older are not required to purchase fishing licenses in Delaware, although exempt persons may purchase fishing licenses and trout stamps

if they so choose to help support fisheries management and trout stocking efforts. Higher stamp and license prices apply to non-resident anglers.

All proceeds from trout stamps are used to purchase next year's fish. Since the price of trout is not expected to decrease in the immediate future, the Fisheries Section is hoping plenty of anglers will come out this season to help support the program.

Downstate trout season remains open in Tidbury Pond in Dover and Newton Pond near Greenwood, both of which were stocked in March. Trout are a cold-water species and can only survive



while water temperatures in the ponds remain cool.

Where has all the bamboo gone?

'Aggressive' plant removed from city walking trail

Newark's Parks and Recreation Department and Water and Wastewater Department recently contracted out the removal of bamboo from an area behind Lewis Park, the Ivy Hall Apartments and around the Academy Street water-treatment building.

Residents walking along the James Hall Trail in that area will notice there is no longer any bamboo, which was causing damage to the asphalt surface of the Hall Trail and the tennis courts in

Lewis Park.

The City was awarded two grants to complete the project — one from the Delaware Forest Service for invasive-species control and the other from New Castle County Conservation District. The project was funded in full with the grants.

Bamboo is an invasive and aggressive plant; once its roots are established, it readily spreads underground and can cause extensive damage to any surface it

uproots. It was also raising concerns about possible damage to the Academy Street water-treatment building that would have caused safety and building-security issues, officials said.

The process of total removal and control of the bamboo will take several years. After the initial cutting, two herbicide applications are needed in the first year to control any regrowth.

One application will be made in mid- to late-May

and the other in mid- to late-September. Thereafter, spot sprays will be used for one to three additional years to eliminate the bamboo. During this time, the native grasses and wildflowers will be encouraged to reclaim the area.

After the bamboo has been totally removed, the Parks and Recreation Department will reforest both areas adjacent to the Hall Trail. Along with the native grasses and wildflowers that reestablish, they will add evergreen and

deciduous trees and shrubs to the area.

The city's first Cash Mob commenced Tuesday evening in front of the Main Street Galleria. The members' collective purpose: to spend a few bucks at a local business.


Stephen Orens, owner of RelyLocal Newark — a franchise of the national

veggie burger, Black Angus short rib burger, pan-seared salmon or hanger steak.

"We don't hold anybody to our thoughts of how something should be prepared," Tunstall said. The menu at Home Grown suits the needs for any palate. Vegans, meat eaters, and dieters alike can all satisfy their appetite here.

As Tunstall and I chatted, I was pleased to hear that many of the ideas for the menu come from what the staff orders for lunch or dinner. If you've ever worked in a restaurant, you can relate to the fact that though the menu may be fantastic, every now and then it's nice to mix and match and create something of your own. I always did this at my family's restaurant, McKinney and Doyle. I'd deconstruct wraps and turn them into salads, or take sandwich components and make a pasta dish. It's fun and often leads to something wonderful ... and sometimes a new menu item.

I made Tunstall laugh again when I asked him what he would select as his favorite menu option if he could only choose one. Once I noticed him struggling a little, I compromised and told him to pick one appetizer and one entrée. That seemed to help a little.

I learned about the Roasted Long Hots appetizer stuffed with roasted-garlic mashed

potatoes and topped with either Andouille sausage or seitan tomato gravy and provolone cheese. Tunstall described long hots as thin, spicy, and flavorful peppers somewhat comparable to jalapenos. The heat doesn't overpower the flavor, he assured me.

Tunstall chose the Mu Shu Burrito as his favorite entrée. It's stuffed with roasted pulled pork or seitan, rice and an Asian vegetable salsa. It's served with a side of apple Kimchee and a spicy ginger mango sauce. Sounds like a perfect combination to me.

There are a lot of reasons to love Home Grown Café, starting first and foremost with the menu. But the atmosphere is not to be overlooked. With awesome happy-hour deals, you can enjoy a big night out on the town, even on a limited budget.

And here's a hint: Order off the wonderful wine list and ask for the Surf and Turf and you can impress any date.

Alone, as a couple or with a group of friends, Home Grown Café is sure to challenge your creativity, and most importantly, quench your cravings.


