Dear Dannie:

I have received through the courtesy of Bachrach, in New York, copies of Dr. Reuter's letter to you of April 5, of your letter to him of April 18, of his letter to you of April 28 and your reply to him of May 3. I have read these with much interest. I can see how much they want you in Berlin and I know how helpful it would be for you to be there and I know how much you want to go. I think that if you are feeling entirely fit you will wish to go, but unless you are feeling entirely fit in the latter part of June I do not think you should go, because such a trip involves a certain amount of strain and stress under the best circumstances. Completely aside from Bewag matters which are so important, there are so many other things which you could usefully discuss while you are abroad. I think, however, that the primary consideration is your own health and I hope you will have that be the controlling factor.

My plans are to leave here around the 14th or 15th of June by air for New York.
