A letter from Joe

As the nation commemorates October as Domestic Violence Awareness month, I want to thank all of the domestic violence service providers for everything you do.

This past September marked the 14th anniversary of the passage of the Violence Against Women Act—my proudest legislative accomplishment in the United States Senate.

Since that time, we have worked passionately to move mountains in this battle. Thanks to the efforts of VAWA's supporters across our state, domestic violence incidents here in Delaware have been reduced by over 1,000 since 2001 and the nearly 250 Delawareans, 133 of them children, who sought shelter in Kent and Sussex Counties in 2006, had a safe place to go.

It is inspiring to see the encouragement and protection these advocates provide to victims. Each year, more people take the courageous step to report these terrible crimes. In 2006, Delaware's family court processed more than 3,000 protection petitions, the most ever.

We have an army of resources nationwide and each year we are reaching and helping more families in Delaware and across the nation.



As you know too well though, we still have a way to go. One in four women still experiences some sort of abuse in her lifetime. It takes enormous courage for the abused to walk away—we need to make sure all victims know that help is available.

I know that there is still much work to do, families to help, and promises to keep. That's why I introduced legislation that would build an army of 100,000 volunteer lawyers to help victims of abuse.

We are proud that fourteen years later, VAWA has helped countless families find strength, and the power to fight back.


Joe at the Jefferson-Jackson Dinner this week

Biden keeps one foot on campaign trail, the other in Senate business

Excerpts from *The News Journal* article, 10/1/08

WASHINGTON —Sen. Joe Biden's return to Washington today for the latest legislative attempt at addressing the financial crisis on Wall Street will mark his first vote since becoming the Democratic vice presidential nominee.

But that doesn't mean he hasn't been keeping a hand in Senate business from the campaign trail.

Since the beginning of September, several pieces of his legislation have either passed the Senate or committees.

His Protect Our Children Act, providing resources to fight Internet crimes against children, passed both houses last week and is awaiting President Bush's signature.

He introduced a bill. Actually, Sen. Majority Leader Harry Reid physically dropped the bill, which would help fund and equip local law enforcement agencies to respond to a terrorism attack. But Biden is the lone sponsor.

"He talks to multiple members of the Senate staff every day by phone, getting updates and providing direction on constituent concerns, committee agendas and Legislative items", said his spokeswoman Elizabeth Alexander in a statement...

Still, he's reached out in ways that one observer - the former chief of staff for Sen. Joe Lieberman when he ran for vice president - said was "above and beyond the call of duty."

He called the new bishop of Wilmington, the Most Rev. W. Francis Malooly, when he was installed to congratulate him and addressed the Delaware Volunteer Firefighters Association luncheon via their public address system...

Biden, who chairs the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, has been in touch regularly with Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice, according to his office. His bill promoting the trade of nuclear fuel and technology between the United States and India is scheduled for a Senate vote tonight.

He met with Georgian President Mikheil Saakashvili on Sept. 26 and has spoken with Afghanistan President Hamid Karzai, Pakistani President Asif Ali Zardari and Columbia President Alvaro Uribe.






HELPING FAMILY BUDGETS








Delaware's Joe Biden Health Care We Can Afford


Encourage prevention and modernization.

Joe Biden. Leading the Way in Honoring Our Troops and Veterans.



Supporting our troops on the battlefield

Joe Biden was the leader in getting Mine Resistant Ambush Protected Vehicles (MRAPs) to our troops in Iraq and Afghanistan as quickly as possible. MRAPs reduced by more than two-thirds American injuries and deaths from roadside bombs.

Improving health care for all veterans

Senator Biden was instrumental in keeping the VA Hospital in Elsmere open and getting community-based outpatient clinics opened in Dover and Georgetown. He has long supported mandatory funding for the VA so that veterans' health care is not subject to yearly votes. He is committed to continuing to expand screening and treatment for veterans suffering from Post Traumatic Stress Disorder and Traumatic Brain Injury.



Reforming the handling of disability claims

Senator Biden will reduce the waiting time for veterans to receive the benefits they are owed. He will improve technology and boost staffing levels in the Veterans Benefits Administration, which will reduce the unacceptable backlog of pending claims. He knows we must update and simplify the system.

Expanding educational and job opportunities

Senator Biden co-sponsored the new GI Bill. It provides veterans who have served since September 11, 2001 with a level of educational benefits like those given to service members after World War II. Senator Biden supports successful programs like Helmets to Hardhats and Troops to Teachers to help veterans find jobs after military service.
