

Cape Blanco, Oregon 1976

Close-up view of Pleistocene shells at Cape Blanco. Remarkably thick unit with well-preserved large shells of various bivalves. Elevation of terrace deposit is ~60 m. Samples from this site were collected in 1981 for use as interlaboratory sample ILC-A (Wehmiller, 1984).
