- 3. UD students transferring between the Colleges of Arts and Sciences, and Human Services, Education, and Public Policy will find it easier to transfer courses fulfilling breadth requirements, because the revised breadth requirements incorporate existing College of Arts and Sciences breadth requirements. This is an important issue because the Human Services major receives many of its majors through internal transfers.
