


### Provide Health Care for the Sick (Definitely Yes)






### Provide a decent standard of living for the old (Definitely Yes)






## Provide a decent standard of living for the unemployed (Definitely Yes)




## Give financial help to university students from low income families (Definitely Yes)






### Keep prices under control (Definitely Yes+Probably Yes)





## Impose strict laws to make industry do less damage to the environment (Definitely Yes)






