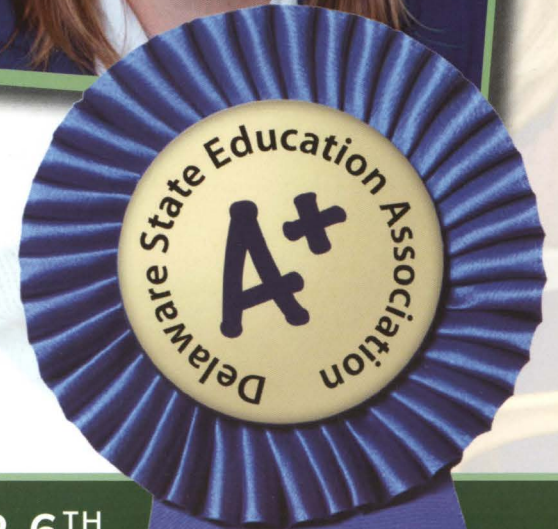

When Rep. Deborah Hudson was contacted by a constituent about changing Delaware's law to allow child sexual abuse victims to be compensated for damages years after they were abused, she joined forces with retired State Senator Karen Peterson, a Democrat, and, together, they championed the successful passage of the "**Child Victim's Act.**" In 2007, the landmark Senate Bill 29 was signed, **repealing the statute of limitations for child sexual abuse civil cases.** Tom Conaty of Woodbrook, on behalf of his brother (a child sex abuse victim) **wrote to thank Rep. Hudson for her leadership** as a prime sponsor of this law. **In Tom's own words, he is supporting Rep. Hudson:**

...I cannot say enough about Debbie's leadership, strength, dedication and effectiveness as a legislator...

It's notable that these two amazing women worked together across party lines to lead a diverse and impressive coalition of Delawareans to an overwhelming victory for children...

Debbie Hudson has shown true leadership and earned our family's respect, gratitude, admiration, friendship and eternal support.

Thank goodness our family reached out to Rep. Hudson for help. She showed tremendous courage, not as a mere politician, but as a friend, a mother, a neighbor, and a true leader.

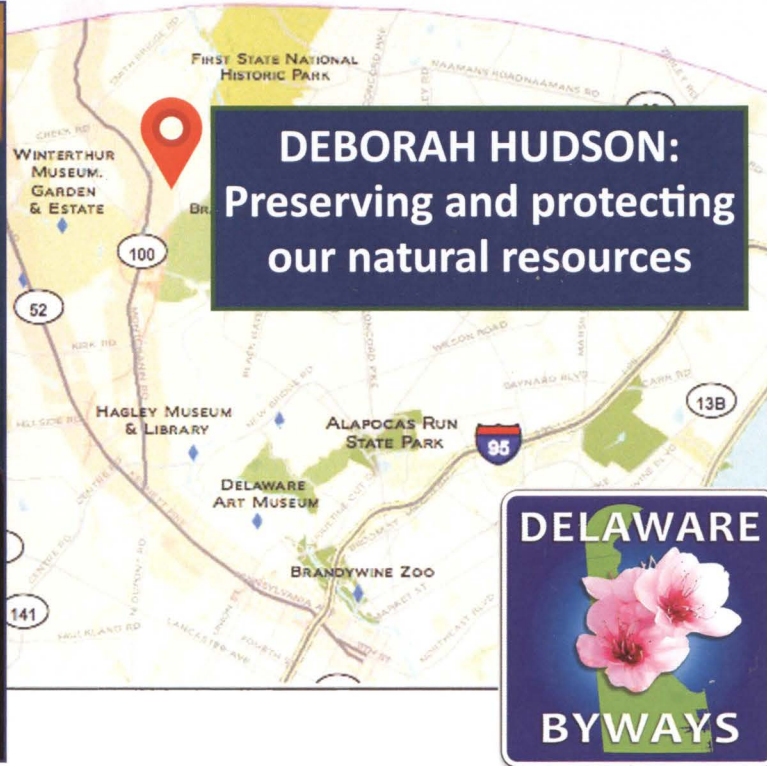

birthday, we got devastating news.
Leukemia.**



Our family was lucky. I could leave my job as Deputy Attorney General and sit at Nate's bedside because we could afford it and we had good health insurance.

For so many families, that's just not an option.

The toll on families who have to leave a young child alone in the hospital so that parents can work and keep their health insurance is devastating. Families shouldn't have to choose between quality medical care for their loved one and keeping a roof over their head. Our current system puts too much of a burden on patients who are fighting for their lives.

Nate has successfully completed cancer treatments and is now a healthy, happy four-year-old in remission.

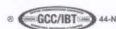
Since then, I've dedicated myself to health care nonprofits and community service.
