## MEMORANDUM.

In connection with the Einstein case, Consul General Messersmith received many letters from persons at home and in Europe, but as these letters were of a personal nature and came from friends, they were not included in the official file; similarly, a very considerable number of clippings from American newspapers and publications which reached Consul General Messersmith have not been included in the file as they came to him in a personal way and he prefers to keep them for his personal file. He has also received a personal note from Secretary of State Stimson and from Assistant Secretary Carr, expressing appreciation of the way in which he and Mr. Geist and the Berlin Consulate handled the Einstein case, indicating complete satisfaction on the part of the Department with the way the case was handled.
