# Tough choices loom for schools picked as under-performers

Two Christina district schools, designated as underperformers, have been put on notice as part of a state program that uses a carrot and stick approach of additional resources, as well as stark choices that include closing, conversion to a charter school or shedding half of existing staff.

The annoucement of the "Partnership Zone" was announced by Secretary of Education Lillian M. Lowery on Tuesday. Additional schools will receive the designation next year.

A former Christina Superintendent, Lowery announced that Glasgow High School and Stubbs Elementary School in Wilmington will join Positive Outcomes Charter School in Camden and Howard High School of Technology in Wilmington.

These schools will now be part of a newly created "Partnership Zone." Partnership Zone schools

Partnership Zone schools will benefit from grants of up to \$2.2 million over four years to carry out one of four models for significantly improving student performance at the school, with closing as one of the options that are outlined as follows:

- Closing

   District closes

  into other schools.
- Restart District converts a school into a public charter school pursuant to the

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# Females use pepper spray in street robbery

A street robbery that involved the use of pepper spray by two females occurred on North Chapel Street, just off of East Main Street, at 1:30 a.m. on Saturday August 28, Newark Police reported. The two female victims were walk-ing on N. Chapel St. when two other females approached them from behind. The victims were sprayed in the face with pepper spray, and one was tackled to the ground. Both victims then had their purses taken by the suspects. The suspects were last seen entering a red or maroon car that was driven away from the area northbound on N. Chapel St. At the time of this release, a more detailed description of the suspects is not available. Both victims are 21 years old. One of the victims suffered a scraped knee that did not require medical attention. The other was not injured.

# 30 graffiti charges

Newark Department has charged Brian Durkee in connection with 30 graffiti incidents dating back to January 2009. Durkee had been previously suspected of the crimes, but recently discovered postings on his MySpace account provided suffi-

cient proof for a warrant to be issued for his arrest. Durkee is charged with illegally applying his tag to 30 locations, all along Main Street. He was picked up August 26 while he was on Main St. The charges are 30 counts of Graffiti and 30 counts of Possession of a Graffiti Implement. After an initial court appearance, he was released upon posting a \$3,000 secured bond.

# **Dickey Park target** of criminal mischief

Last week, employees of the Newark Public Works department reported that several incidents of graffiti and one act of arson were seen in Dickey Park, located at 60 Madison

On Monday, employees said that they observed the graffiti tag "Beond" or "Beyond" in green spray paint on the Dickey Park pool house. Similar markings were also seen at 70 Madison Dr., though that property is not owned by the city. The damage to the pool house is estimated at \$200.

On Thursday, the tag "BEOnD1" was seen on a bench in the same park. Both instances of vandalism were photographed and entered into a central database for comparison to past investigations.

Finally, also on Thursday, a slide and bubble panel belonging to a playground set was found burned. Police suspect that the fire had been set the night before. Parks police had reported several instances of vandalized equipment this

A search by police showed that a pile of mulch on the basketball court had been attempted to have been ignited first, though parks employees stated that the landscaping material will not burn.

The cost to replace the damaged equipment is \$800. No suspects have been named in any of the cases.

# **Business gets phone** cable cut

Newark Police are investigating a cut phone line at Shamrock Printing Co., at 261 E. Main St., Newark.

Representatives of the firm reported that sometime

last weekend, unknown suspects had cut the phone cable, depriving the business of phone and Internet services. The responding officers stated that the cable had a clean cut at both ends, suggesting that wire cutters were used for the act. A rain gutter next to the cable had also been damaged.

No video surveillance or witnesses were recovered and no suspects have been named.

# Banned from UD campus

Albert H. Baldwin has been banned from the

He was given an unconditional trespass warning after he made frequent visits to the computer lab in Smith Hall

According to police, Baldwin is a Tier I (lowest level) registered sex offender with a history of violent behavior, resisting arrest and fleeing from law enforcement.

# Parks worker killed

A New Castle County parks worker died when his lawn tractor overturned in the Pike Creek. New Castle County Police reported the accident occurred today at Carousel Park. The incident happened at 12:17 p.m.

at the park, along Del. Route 7. It was the second fatal parksrelated accident in the past two years. A tree claimed the life of another county worker. A preliminary investigation revealed a county seasonal employee, identified as 68-year-old James Hagerty, was preparing to cut grass on a hill near a pond this afternoon when, for an unknown reason, his lawn tractor slid back down the hill, went over an embankment and overturned into a creek bed.

Hagerty, who was pinned under the tractor, was pronounced dead at the scene. However, the exact cause of death still is under investiga-

Carousel Park is a 216-acre facility. The accident happened off Enchanted Lake Circle, a gravel road that rings the pond in the northeastern part of the

Hagerty was previously a full-time county employee who worked as a special equipment operator from December 2001 to December 2006. He retired and returned to work as a seasonal employee in May 2010. Seasonal employees work about nine months out of the year, mostly in the maintenance of county parks and other facili-

County Executive Chris Coons and other officials went to Hagerty's home to express their condolences to his wife and children.

"We are all deeply saddened by this tragedy," Coons said. "This is a huge loss. Mr. Hagerty was a dedicated part of our family who worked so hard to serve the public."

The accident remains under investigation.

# **Burglars surprised**

Two teen burglars were surprised by the occupant of a home in the Beech Hill community between Newark and Hockessin and dropped tomatoes and a bottle of liquor while fleeing the scene.

New Castle County Police went to the home on Deer Track early Monday morning for a report of a burglary in progress. When police arrived, they found the victim who told officers he was startled by the sounds of a person moving around in his home. He searched his home and found a white male burglar standing outside his office window and when he entered his garage he noticed another subject near the freezer.

The subject looked at the victim and fled out the garage door dropping a bottle of liquor and some tomatoes outside the garage. Both subjects were seen running toward Beech Hill Drive.



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# **Guest bartenders to** aid police K9 fund

Paco the Newark K-9 police officer has recently been diag-nosed with Bi-lateral Hip Dysplasia, which means he can be in a lot of pain if overly exerted. His retirement potential is high and right now there is not enough money in the Newark Police Department's K-9 Unit fund to purchase, train and house a new K-9.

The K-9 Unit relies on the support from the Main Street Mile fund raiser every year. Currently, the fund is at approximately \$5,000. The annual Main Street Mile is important because it helps pay for continued training and certifications for the K-9 and its handler. With Paco's retirement looming, the fund raiser has become even more important since the initial cost of a K-9 is approximately \$10,000 with an additional one time cost of about \$1,000 for kennel set-up at the handler's home. Other incidentals cost approximately \$1,500 a year. Veterinary care is donated by a local veterinarian.

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# **More 'Movies That Matter' at Film Festival**

Six years ago, after a viewing of "Paperclips"—a film chronicling the journey of middle school students from a small Tennessee town as they attempt to do a project on the Holocaust—a lady walked over to Barry Schlecker, and hugged him. The explanation she gave for her action: "You show movies that matter."

"Movies that Matter" has become the tagline for the Newark Film Festival and Executive Producer Barry Schlecker is still as pumped as ever to bring thought-provoking, off-beat and entertaining films to Delaware.

"We draw from a variety of sources to find films—big festivals like Sundance and Cannes, films that are generating buzz on the independent film circuit, recommendations from our trusty board of film-buffs," explained Assistant to the Producer Bailey Kung. "We try to pick films that will resonate with different audiences. We like to keep a balance of genres and subjects so that there's something for everyone—we look for films that really have something to say, be it politi-



cally, socially, or artistically," she continued. From the inspiring story of a Laos-American fashion designer in "Dressed" to the effect of technology on social interactions played out in "In 200 Characters or Less" to the lush cinematography backdropping the tension between self-fulfilment and familial obligations in "I Am Love," this season's

lineup plays with the provocative, embraces the inspirational, and most importantly, places a priority on captivating filmmaking.

The movie Schlecker is the most excited to show, however, is a title that many people should be familiar with: "The Girl with the Dragon Tattoo," based on the best-selling book of the same name by Steig Larssen. "It's too

long, it's subtitled—pretty much everything I hate in a movie—but I can't wait to see it again. I was on the edge of my seat for all two hours and 30 minutes," he said. "We're going to show it as a double feature with 'The Girl Who Played with Fire'."

"I think I'm most excited about 'Exit Through the Gift Shop,' "Kung added. "It's about Banksy, a world famous street artist. There's a lot of speculation over the authenticity of Guetta's work and the film—which is supposed to be a documentary—itself. Street art is such a great blend of recognition and anonymity already, and to have this film be the exact same way is just so great," she continued.

She was quick to add, however, "And from a purely voyeuristic stand-point, I am looking forward to the 'Grease Sing-A-Long.' There's going to be a costume contest. I can't wait to see who shows up and watch them all having a ball singing with the film."

Originally brought to life out Schlecker's frustration with Delaware's independent movie offerings, the Newark Film Festival has become a staple of the community's fall line-up, eagerly anticipated by Newark residents, university students, and downtown business owners alike.

"You used to only have three options," Schlecker explained. "You could drive to the Ritz in Philadelphia and hope to get

home before the Phillies game let out; plan your schedule so you're home the weekend the film you want to see is playing at Theatre N; or wait a year until the movie comes out Netflix, Now, once a year, you can overdose on great movies at a reasonable price," he said.

Kung echoed Schlecker's thoughts on the uniqueness of this annual event. "As a Newark lifer, I really love this event because there's nothing like it. Newark is a small town and the Film Festival is a taste of something so much bigger," she said. "We show national and international films that wouldn't otherwise make it to this town, or even Delaware."

"I think my favorite part of the Film Festival, though, is the community," she continued. "I started as a volunteer two years ago, just selling and tearing tickets. Movies are so powerful and such a wonderful thing to share. It's so nice to usher people into the theater and say, 'Right this way. You're going to have a great time.'

The Newark Film Festival will take place on Sept. 23-30 at Cinema Center 3 in the Newark Shopping Center and on Oct. 1-3 at the Delaware Art Museum in Wilmington. Tickets are \$7 for single admission, \$18 for a 3-pack, \$30 for a 6-pack, and \$75 for a festival pack. For a full-list of films playing, visit www.newarkfilm.com.

# **Vendor puts Social Security information online**

State of Delaware consultant, Aon Consulting is mailing letters to approximately 22,000 State of Delaware retirees, after the company included Social Security Numbers, gender information and dates of birth in a Request for Proposal (RFP) the company prepared for the state.

This information was accidentally posted to the procurement section of the state website for five days before state staff discovered and removed it,

Aon Consulting, Chicago, provides services to the State of Delaware for health and benefit programs. This document did not include retiree names or current state employee information.

Aon had prepared an RFP for

the State of Delaware to solicit bids from insurance companies interested in providing vision benefits to employees and retirees of the State. The RFP was posted to the procurement section of the state website to allow interested bidders access to the proposal document (the normal course of business for a public entity, such as the State of Delaware". The document included the above mentioned information.

The state Office of Management and Budget along with representatives from the Delaware Department of Technology and Information, the Office of the Attorney General and the State Pension Office, are overseeing the steps Aon is taking to support persons affected by this incident and prevent future incidents of this nature.

This incident response is also governed by federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) regulations. Aon Consulting is taking the following actions:

 Aon Consulting will contact each affected individual with a letter informing them of the incident and credit protection steps moving forward.


 Aon Consulting will post public notices in states where there are more than 500 affected individuals,

- Notification will be provided to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services of the security incident.

While HIPAA regulations provide that these actions occur within 60 days, OMB has confirmed these actions will be complete by the end of the week.

Aon Consulting will also provide one year of free credit monitoring through Experian, a leading global credit monitoring company. Aon Consulting has also set up a customer care toll-free line at 866-623-6047. The phone lines will be open from Monday to Friday, 8am - 8pm.

Aon's letters to potentially affected retirees will further detail the situation and outline instructions to access the Experian services to put a fraud alert on their files.

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# Are you ready for some R

Dumb, knuckle-dragging buffoons.

That's the description that University of Delaware rugby coach Bjorn Haglid says is generally associated with rugby players. But he quickly added that, in reality, rugby players must not only be athletic, but smart.

"Rugby is like a chess match," Haglid, who attended Concord High School and is a self-employed structural engineer, said during a phone interview. "Because of the nature of the game, players have to make all the decisions during it. There are no timeouts, and as much as I'd like to think the players can hear me yelling instructions from the sideline, I know they can't. So they have to be able to manage the game, analyze the situation and figure out a path forward, including strengths and weaknesses of the other team."

The UD Rugby Club boasts 70 members and a top-10 national ranking (No. 9 in Rugbymag.com) among the 31 teams that make up the top tier of college rugby clubs. The Hens compete in the National College Premiere Division 1 - East Conference, along with Penn State, Navy, Army, Ohio State, Rutgers, Dartmouth and Kutztown.

Delaware will open its fall home schedule Friday night against St. Joe's at 6 p.m, Friday. The game will be played on the practice fields behind the Delaware Field House and admission is free. (Note: remaining home games will be played on Frazier Field behind the Carpenter Sports Building/Little Bob.)

The game itself, which is made up of two 40-minute halves running clock, only lasts approximately 90 minutes and Haglid is hoping Newark residents and UD students will put their stereotypes aside and come enjoy rugby for the sport itself.

"Rugby is really a safe and entertaining sport," the ninthyear volunteer coach said. "In the world of contact sports, it's actually very safe. There are lots of rules to ensure the longevity of players, not only during a game but throughout their playing careers. It's not nearly as brutal as it seems."

Those rules include only being able to tackle the person carrying the ball, and the tackle must be a "wrap" below the waist, not a hit like often seen in the NFL. There also is no blocking, which eliminates the blindside hitting that often causes injuries in football. Failure to follow any of these rules can result in an ejection.

A "try" is the equivalent of an NFL touchdown, only its

worth five points. And if you are wondering why a player with the ball in the end zone is still being chased it's because he is trying to get close to the center of the end zone. The score is not official until the player actually touches the ball down to the ground. Once touched down, the team backs straight up and tries the 2-point conversion, which can be a punt or dropkick. The closer to the center of the end zone the ball is touched down, the easier the conversion. Imagine an NFL kicker trying to convert an extra point from the sideline.

A scrum, which Haglid says "looks like a massive hug on the field," is where the chess match comes in. A scrum occurs whenever a ball is deemed unplayable. Eight players lock arms in a pyramid shape and try to push the other team's pyramid of players away from the incoming ball and gain control of it. Haglid says that obviously the bigger your players are the more of an advantage you have in the scrums, but with only seven substitutes allowed per game, those bigger players wear down faster than a smaller player might.

Haglid didn't start playing rugby until he attended the University of Delaware, where he quickly learned that being part of a rugby club not only provides athletic participation, but the opportunity to grow as a

student and future professional.

"The rugby club serves a dual purpose," he said. "It introduces students to a great team sport as underclassmen and then as seniors they take ownership of the team and become officers and learn how to run a team, much like they would a small company. Being part of the club helps with their educational and personal and professional development. It's like managing a company of 70 people."

The club promotes the sport at local elementary schools and this past summer conducted a week-long clinic at the Sanford School Day Camp. Haglid says they hope to continue to eliminate the stereotypes of rugby, while increasing interest in a sport that he says is the fastest growing high school sport in the country over the past five years.

Here locally, it all starts this Friday night behind the Delaware Field House at 6 p.m. And remember, you can't beat the price!



requirements of Chapter 5 of Title 14 of the Delaware Code, or closes and reopens a school under a charter school operator, a charter management organization or an education management organization that has been selected through a rigorous review process.

 Transformation – School makes significant changes in its governance and operation, including making changes to teacher evaluation consequences and modifying instructional

• Turnaround - School makes significant changes in governance, staffing and operation including removing at least 50% of the current staff.

School districts and charter schools responsible for the Partnership Zone schools must now select one of the four models. The Department of Education expects the districts and charter school will work with the affected school communities, especially parents, and with the Department to determine which

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of the four Partnership Zone models is best and what the specific strategies will be for that school.

The school districts and charter school will have three months to work with school communities to develop a plan for their strategy for approval by the Delaware Department of Education. Lowery said she will work closely with the leadership of the school districts and charter school and believes they will submit aggressive and innovative plans for improvement. She will meet individually with each of the four schools' larger school communities to provide additional information and answer

any questions. Partnership Zone school models may utilize some of the following strategies to improve students' academic achievement: longer hours, including more learning time for students; more collaboration time for teachers; enrichment activities for students: changes in school leadership and staff; and meaningful family and community engagement.

According to the state department, schools were selected in a two-step process that included both a quantitative analysis to determine the persistently lowest achieving schools on the state's reading and math tests and a qualitative analysis by the secretary that considered factors generated with input from various stakeholder groups.

"Partnership is the right word here. It's about working together to deliver stronger public schools for our children and better results

for us all," stated Gov. Jack Markell. "Our young people will be competing for future jobs in a global workforce that demands a strong educational foundation and we are focused on working

together to make that a reality." "Now I'm issuing a call to action so that all of our schools have the chance to be great. Each and every student must be given the opportunity to be ready for college and prepared to compete for the next generation of jobs," Lowery said. "I am committed to working with the administrators, teachers, families and others in the inaugural Partnership Zone school communities to ensure we identify innovative strategies to improve outcomes for their students."

Partnership Zones schools were also part of the blueprint for change the state spelled out when it explained its efforts in its successful application for the federal Race to the Top effort. Delaware was one of only two states to win the initial federal Race to the Top initiative, which came with \$119 million to support efforts to improve the quality of education in the state. The plan the state submitted included the support of every school district, superintendent, charter school and charter school director.

# **Bookstore project under way**

The University of Delaware and Barnes and Noble broke ground for construction of the new UD Bookstore during an event on Monday.

UD has partnered with Barnes and Noble since 2002 and at the ceremony UD President Patrick Harker announced that the University has signed a new 15-year contract extension to continue the collaboration.

"We're calling this a ground opening instead of a groundbreaking for a couple of reasons," Harker told those gathered for the event, held in a tent on the large tract that touches Main Street, Academy Street and Delaware Avenue. "Locating this bookstore on Main Street really opens us up to the town. Newark is so important to UD, and UD to Newark, and this will be such a lively intersection of city and University. Great univer-

sities help build great neighborhoods, and I can't wait to see the kind of energy this bookstore brings to an already thriving downtown."

The opening of a bookstore, Harker said, also "opens up the life of the mind. It opens us up to intellectual debate, to the exchange of ideas, and opinions, and the things that matter. This project, as much as any other, is a recommitment to our mission to cultivate a truly inclusive community of thought and scholarship. It'll be a great venue for professors and writers not only to share their work with students, residents, and visitors, but to really engage them in it."

Harker acknowledged Mark Sanderson, a principal in the firm Digsau, which is serving as the architect on the project, and Rob Buccini from the design-build contractor Buccini/Pollin before introducing Max Roberts, president of Barnes and Noble College Booksellers.

Roberts, who grew up in Newark, Ohio, and has lived in Newark, N.J., for 25 years, joked about the pronunciation differences between the three cities before talking about the ground opening of the new bookstore.

"This ceremony is about beginnings," Roberts said. "It's about the beginning of a new school year and it's about the beginning of a new construction project, and it's the beginning of a new era in Barnes and Noble's relationship with the University of Delaware and the greater community of Newark.

"The structure for which we're breaking ground here today is going to be more than just a beautiful college superstore. What we're going to build here is a modern day village green -- a place that will welcome UD and Newark communities, a knowledge center where people of all ages will come to feed their intellectual curiosity, connect with peers, or maybe just find a comfortable place to study. This is a very exciting project and we are very proud to be a part of it."

Roberts also spoke about the technological advances that have taken place in the eight years since UD's partnership with Barnes and Noble began, noting that customers will have the option to make their purchases or sell their books from the store or online at the bookstore's website, with options of getting new, used or digital books. 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# The advantages of being a Locavore?

Those who prefer to eat locally grown/produced food sometimes call themselves locavores or localvores. There is a growing trend toward supporting locally grown produce and products. Whether it's to support your local producers and our economy, to reap the benefits of buying freshly picked products right off the farm, knowing your local farmer or better understanding where your food comes from, many people have started buying local. But are you ready for a local product throwdown?

Becoming a locavore can be challenging. It seems like such a simple decision. Just eat local, right? But what is local? Within 50 miles? 100 miles? A day's drive? Is it what is in our food shed?

If you go by miles, we in the mid-Atlantic are quite blessed. Even I you consider local "100 miles," just think, we can have seafood, fresh greens, apples, peaches, corn, tomatoes, many canned food products and lots of wonderful things. But if you become a strict locavore, are you willing to give up coffee, pineapples, lemons, peanuts or olive oil; many things that can't be grown in our region. For me, it would be tough to get up each morning without coffee.

Do you read labels to determine where the product is grown or packaged or produced? For example with a little online research you can determine that local Delaware lima beans, as an example, are sent to New Jersey to be packaged and distributed? That Furmano's canned products are locally purchased and processed in central Pennsylvania and then redistributed to the east coast retailers.

There is the seasonality of produce and products as well. Do you only eat what is in season? Do you preserve local foods so you have them in the off season? I love to freeze and can but I know others don't have the time and resources to do this.

There is much to consider when taking on the challenge of becoming a locavore. Cooperative Extension will be conducting a program entitled Getting the Most out of Eating Locally on September 8th from 6:30-8:30pm in the county extension office to help you

learn more about this trend and how you can begin to integrate this into your own life while saving money on your food bill. Pre-registration is required and there is a cost of \$15. Go to the New Castle County extension office website http://ag.udel.edu/extension/ncc/nccindex.php for the registration material and click on Nutrition and Wellness Programs.

I know I'd lose the throwdown but I'd be a good contender. By taking little steps, reviewing what my families eating preferences, making connections to my local producers and farmers markets, and reading labels, I've slowly been able to integrate more local products and produce into my fridge, freezer and pantry. I guess I'd classify myself as a semi-locavore, You could too.
