This is just a word to acknowledge your letter which you dictated over the phone. You should not have taken the trouble to write me, but Marion and I are glad to have this word from you.



It is going to take a lot of time and a lot of patience, but in any event all that is happening is encouraging and you can look forward to a future much more free of preoccupation.

I am on the whole feeling pretty well, but I have a great deal of discomfort. One day I feel fine and the next day I am bothered with these abdominal pains which my doctor here says have nothing to do with the hernia of the oesophagus and which are not serious. I am pretty well discouraged because the pain can be pretty bad. I had not planned to go north until the beginning of June but if I do not feel better during the next two weeks or so I shall go north to see the doctor there.

There is much to write about but I want to spend the week-end in Cuernavaca so this is just a very brief note to tell you how glad I am that things are going so well. Our thoughts are very much with you all and we miss you here.
