Dear Sister

I received your Letter

and was glad to hear from you and to hear  
that you was well we are still on the eastern  
Shore of Virginia the most good for Saken

very good health until now and i have  
had a very bad cold But it is got Better  
the people is very poor Down here and  
in the interior part of the State they are  
in a Starving Condition you Said  
alfred Sent his love to me you can  
tell him for me that his Love was  
not accepted By me tell him that  
I will never write to him until he  
writes to me if that is never

Rigement was engaged a gainst

Legion the fight Lasted 20  
minuter and we quit with
