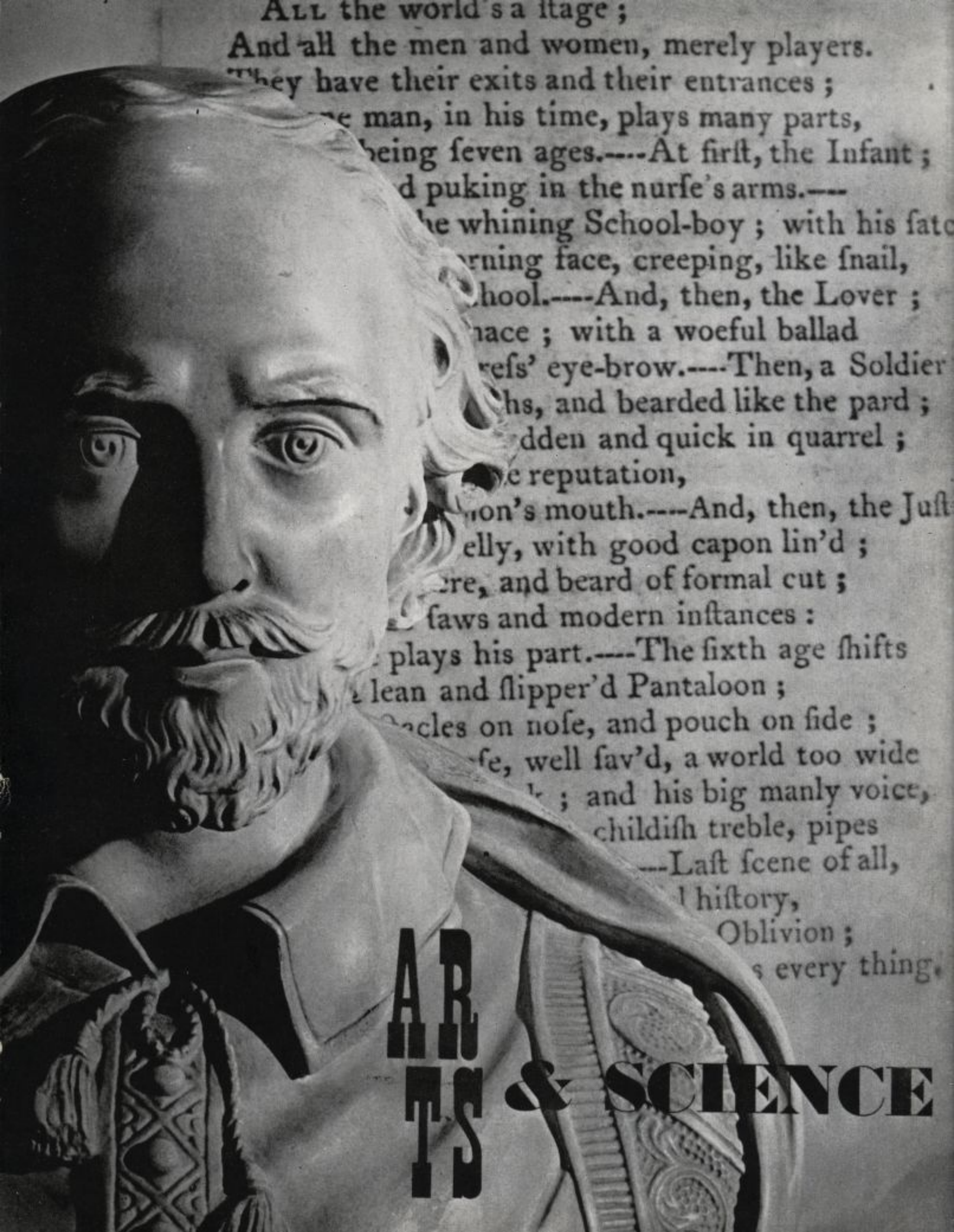




ALL the world's a stage ;

The School of Arts and Science is the parent school of the University, the center around which other schools have developed. It is the direct descendant of the academy which the Reverend Francis Alison opened in New London, Pennsylvania in 1743. Although its curriculum bears little resemblance to that of 1743, its central purpose remains the same; to provide a liberal education which will assure the fullest development of the student as an individual and a citizen. Its program of studies is designed to correlate with this liberal education the specialized courses necessary to prepare the student for service in many occupations and professions.

During the first two years of a student's college course, emphasis is placed upon basic skills and introductory courses in the great fields of human knowledge. In the last two years, the choice of a field of concentration gives the student the opportunity and the incentive to go beyond the elementary levels of a subject into its higher

and more difficult reaches.

The degree of Bachelor of Arts is awarded to those students who follow a broad course of study in the Liberal Arts; the degree of Bachelor of Science is awarded to students who elect more specialized curricula in chemistry, business administration, and physics.

The School of Arts and Science offers graduate courses through the Division of Graduate Study and extra-mural courses through the Extension Division of the University. These activities emphasize the fact that the School of Arts and Science has responsibilities beyond its own program of studies. It also provides services for all other schools and divisions of the University.

Among important recent developments are the authorization of the Department of Chemistry to offer work leading to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy and the establishment of the Department of Dramatic Arts and Speech.
