"RELIGION OF JESUS"

Topic is a strange and difficult one and it is only a part of the story. Title bound to strike a curious note because we don't usually speak about his religion. The reason is that if Jesus, God, he cannot have any religion; if Jesus, God he cannot have relation with himself or object of worship does not himself have a religion, or, because far transcending ours, it would be left aside because not comprehended by us.

Heresies of early centuries had a fault, either they diminished the God-like qualities of Jesus, or the man-like qualities of Jesus, while Christianity tried to hold on to both. The way these heresies were struggled against shows that there must have been divine guidance in the churches. This we can follow gladly: (Appolonarian idea of Jesus denounced his manhood.)?

The full implication of what church clung to has been too often overlooked, "very God and very man". Church taught very manhood of Christ. His religious experience was real and is in line with human experience along road of communion with God.

I've gone to gospels again and marked passages which seem to me to reveal the religion of Jesus:

We've witnessed him in so many experiences in agony, in praying, in communion with his father.

Church has clung to this thought (note the creed! Very God and very man) If so, his experiences must have been the kind man may have. I had it pressed on me as a boy that Jesus was Divine and I thought some how his temptation for him had no meaning and in like manner so Gethsemane I thought not real to him (thought transfiguration did seem more God-like).

It was told me that he was God-head and possibility of him having religious experience was never thought of or spoken of.

Renault's "Life of Christ" helped to bring Jesus down to earth and he was shown as a teacher.

John Hughes refers to non-Christian writer who said of himself, "I am equal with God". This may be understood but is difficult. Another indicative teaching, "what does it profit a man if he win the world and loose his soul, as shepherd looketh after his lost sheep, so does God love you".

What great revelation gave this to Jesus. The whole way is scattered with these emphasizes on human values. "The authority of Jesus", even his enemies saw it. No education, hence, where came it.

Fox spoke with authority. How did Jesus get it? Not from Rabbinical schools. Centurion recognized authority in Jesus. Guidance; we don't see his soul growing, but it must have, facing difficulties and temptations. Then John Hughes compared how George Fox went to Scotland and was warned not to travel because of threats to kill him, and he faced it and went through and not a hand was laid upon him.

Do any of us know how we may be encircled by love of God? At Gethsemane when he said to solders "I am he", they fell back to ground. Such things happened to Fox. That sense of kinship with God, we of Quakers must understand. Habit of plain speech of early Quakers came not from Bible but from first-hand experience. You are Son of God and your word must stand. ("Let your words be ye ye and nay nay"). Jesus thinks of internals and not externals.

His insight into trend of Christianity was marvelous. His teaching on Sabbath. "Sabbath made for man, not man for Sabbath". How was it he went through exterior form into living principle? "Not what goes into man but what comes out of him that makes man unclean". Think how he lays emphasis on inner treasure of heart; think regarding washing of hands; think regarding outlook on nature; think regarding confidence in God. "God's love does not protect his favored and best-beloved children from ordinary happenings in life. God's love is in the heart and goes with him through his trouble. (See John XIII; 2) Jesus said, "Were they sinners on whom the Tower of Siloam fell?".

'Twas not reward of Evil, God does not work that way. Saint will get wet in rain as well as sinner. There Jesus gives you a religion and a philosophy in one stroke. When you've got to the back of that, you've got the whole of religious philosophy. If you asked me how Jesus knew that, I would say that He was in union with God. He knew what son-ship was; God was in his heart.

R. P. had careful talk with Sidney with reference to the way the bud list should be arrived at. In the course of this conversation it was agreed that various factors entered into the wisest possible decision: 1, being the intrinsic value of the rose, 2, the influences that we controlled in bringing pressure to bear on the customers who order, and 3, with the influences that were being brought to bear upon the customer wholly beyond our control, such as advertising in other people's catalogs, and in the magazines, etc. That it is also agreed that each member of the staff probably is possessed with certain backgrounds of information that would enable him to make a contribution toward the wisest possible solution; that for example the judgment of Marion Hatton on point No.1 would be far greater than say Mr. Hutton's and Paul Graves' combined. On the other hand the judgment of James Todd and Mr. Hutton with reference to the pulling power of certain classes, or varieties, or sets might be considerably in excess of that of Marion Hatton's. whose experience has not been along the same line for as long a time, or in as intense a manner. That what was called for was someone to reconcile all these points of view in order that the best possible combination of judgment might be brought to bear in the ultimate decision with reference to, 1, classes or groups: 2. individual varieties, and 3, quantities with respect to all of them. Also with regard to what should be budded as compared with what might later be bought to better advantage. S.B.H. seemed to think that if R.P. and

R.M.H.could see eye to eye with reference to the majority of cases that there need not be very much difficulty regarding what might be the judgment of the other members of the staff.

Among the Climbers, Jacotte trained horizontally broke beautifully all over. Upon Scorcher out of 13 buds he had 80 ft. of growth in once season, this on seven branches. Kitty Kinnimonth was noteworthy. He calculated 1/7 mile of growth on Mermaid; 94 branches from 3 ft. to 14 ft. One bush has a 25 ft. spread. This, however, is exceeded by Bloomfield Courage. One bush on a trellis 10 ft. high and 50 ft. long, one continuous mass or sheet of blooms, heavier at the top but furnished clear to the base, all blossoms looking right at you. Black Boy was making a wonderful showing. Rosella was in high favor as would Souv. de Claudius Denoyel. Apeles Mestres was true to form, though a bit short. Lady Eleanor, one of George C. Thomas's, he claimed to have little foliage and growing well, but I thought little of it. Romeo not any better than in our trial ground. Emily Gray from Cummings not quite so good as the Emily Gray already in Commerce. Countess of Stradbroke was hugh with rich, red flowers. He says continues blooming for a month and that it should not be pruned. Cli. Los Angeles was as rich as could be, making a fine showing, as was Paul's Lemon Pillar and Prosperity. Bloomfield Lustre, he admitted didn't amount to much. Edna Thomas was vigorous with blossoms like Mrs. Warren E. Lenon. Nora Cunningham most dainty; exquisite blossoms and a great lot of bloom. Barbara of Manifold he didn't care much for. Franceska was rather a weak grower though the buds were good.

Above for the Climbers. Cross had a very pretty assortment of species Roses in which two big bushes of Austrian Copper had made a most famous showing for a short time. They were backed up by Fersian Yellow and Harison's Yellow, Sweetbriar and Lutea. A bush of Arkansana was showing nice blooms. He had a Xanthina that had produced single blossoms from 1924 to 1931, and in 1932 and this year, every bloom was double. He says Nicolas claims that it is a magnified case of sporting.

Sentinal was showing up splendidly. Wyant is now working on the wood of it. McGredy's Ivory gave great promise. Climbing Meteor was right up to form.

In the garden said to be shaded, he has the trees trimmed very high. No roots that interfere and no maple trees or locust trees around. The plants were doing splendidly, and there seemed a tendency for the blooms to come up higher than normal. Mrs. DuPont rose for example had buds sticking upright and was all of 2 to 2½ ft. high.

He had a Rose called Willmottiae that is not like the Willmottiae in our garden, but a hybrid; not so good as either Boskoop or Dr. Hurst's Hybrid. There was another Rose, which he called Van Fleet No. 41, and he had among the Species Roxbourghi or the Burr Rose that he liked very much.
