1888

Dear Mother. I take this

we are as well as could be expected
I have been very well this
week and have my Oats. Sown
and one acre of Potatoes Planted
I will be ready to start plowing
some ground to morrow Lewis
is well and hearty as a Little Rock
he has a Little Brother a week
older to day he is pleased over
him borned on Sunday 11 Oct.
we have not decided on any
name for him we would like
you send us your choice of name
if you have any money is
letting a horse very well and
will soon be a bought if nothing
happens I received a letter from

Henry. Weer on Saturday
they are all well and getting
a long very good he says the
Prospect seems better than in
Wilmington and seems to
be in good spirits Genrelly in
there new home I think I
will be down a lough the
first week in May I
will close hoping you are
all well your son
