The 1968 Blue Hen presents . . .


Golden youths with peroxide hair curling over their eyes and ears skimmed along the sparkling surf while their bikinied bunnies lounged along the beach. Rock rhythms pulsed from discotheques as hips and shoulders gyrated through the night in the latest permutation of the Frug, Monkey, or Jerk. Even the President's daughter swung out doing what clever newsmen called Luci's Watusi! If clothes had gone Mod, the generation had gone mad. Oldsters watched with varying degrees of disgust and envy as hemlines went up and hairlines came down. The sexual revolution was in full swing as teeny boppers and college students revelled in an orgy of unabashed hedonism, unequaled by any generation since the Roaring Twenties.

Suddenly a nation that had voted almost unanimously for peace found itself saddled with a painful, unpopular war in Southeast Asia. The Generation Gap had been equaled by the President's Credibility Gap. Johnson's Great Society was shaken by rising inflation and rioting by the nation's poor. Oppressed minorities struck out against a society spending millions on a war overseas while slum conditions in American cities grew steadily worse.

All the swinging and dancing of the years before seemed suddenly empty and meaningless. The generation was haunted by the specter of the draft and war hovering outside the walls of the academic community. As the pressures and tensions rose, youth searched for new answers or escapes. LSD promised to be an answer for some, an escape for others. A horrified nation watched the spread of a new cult of mind benders extolling a new religion: "Tune in. Turn on. Drop out." 1967 witnessed the birth of the American Hippie.


Delaware students often read wild accounts of their swinging counterparts at other universities. Occasionally a frathouse might whip up a party or two which could approach the image of the swinging generation, but generally, Delaware bore the stigma of being a suitcase college. Student life seemed dull. Apathy was the cry of student leaders. Professors complained of the stale academic atmosphere. Lectures and cultural events were poorly attended.

The student body seemed as still and placid as the tree-lined mall on a spring day. Life drifted along smoothly, and students muttered under their breath about lousy food, early women's hours and no cars on campus. Twice a week freshly shorn Freshmen and Sophomores would block the traffic on Main Street as they marched off to ROTC drill. Saturday night excitement would mean a flick at the State Theater since the movie at the Cinema Center had been playing for the entire semester.

A true thirst for culture and intellectual stimulation could be slaked at the Phoenix, the last stronghold of the dying "Beat" movement of the 50's. Stimulating conversation and instant intellectualism were served with draughts of cold cider at the only night spot open after 11 o'clock on a Saturday night.

Conservative Delaware seemed the immovable "Rock of Ages" amid the raging storm of controversies and problems of the outside world.


Delaware students reacted with fear and amazement at the founding of the Delaware chapter of the Students for a Democratic Society. Administrative bulletins warned that the FBI listed the SDS as a communist affiliated and infiltrated organization. Few thought that such a collection of malcontents could accomplish anything at apathetic Delaware. Few considered the unknown SDS candidate Ray Ceci seriously when he ran against the established power structure for SGA president in the spring of 1967. Campaigning for Student Power, the abolition of women's hours, and the abolition of compulsory ROTC, the SDS rallied a hard core of voters beneath the slogan "We have nothing to lose but our chains" to narrowly defeat status quo candidate Steven Goldberg. With the conservative vote split among three candidates, Ceci had cleverly scored a victory by promising the student body what they wanted from the administration rather than what they thought they could get. A new spirit crackled across the campus-one of defiance, one of power. Delaware had suddenly splashed into the stream of nationwide college movements.


Beside political revolution, the Spring of 1967 heralded the rise of the Delaware coed as the champion of the sexual revolution. Inspired by the passing of a new civil rights law, Delaware women began airing serious complaints about the myriad of restrictions imposed on the weaker sex. AWS Playbill had long served as a forum for coed complaints, and Harrington B, defying AWS censors, delivered perhaps the bawdiest lines ever spoken on a Delaware stage only to have the curtain dropped on them midway through their performance.

With final exams during the coming week, coeds from Russell D organized the Russell Raiders to successfully stage a panty raid on neighboring men's dorm, Russell C Zoo. Repenting of their hasty actions, the Russell Raiders returned the contraband articles to their legitimate owners the following evening in the dining hall. The men of the Zoo were displeased to find that their unmentionables had been dyed pink and returned the compliment with a barage of dining hall rolls.

This incident launched the first campus-wide panty raid at the University. For two long nights, Delaware men and women panty-raided and protested. Students sat in at the President's house, marched the wrong way down one way Main Street, defied state troopers outside Harrington B and snatched panties and undergarments drifting down from eagerly opened windows.

In one short semester Delaware had changed from an academic prison haunted by fear and suspicion, to a University of active, excited students. When exams ended, Delaware Students, many with lower than normal grades, left for home to read of their exploits in local papers and to boast to envious parents of their wild forages across the placid Georgian campus that used to be Delaware.
