Dear Dannie :

I am sending you herewith for your purely personal information a copy of a letter which I have written to Tom Mann, No. 2 man in the organization dealing with Latin American affairs in the State Department, viz., No. 1 man under Ed Miller. I am writing to him instead of directly to Ed Miller as I am sure that he will inform Ed Miller fully concerning this letter. I am not sending you the enclosures mentioned in the letter, as the one to Assistant Secretary Perkins you have already seen and the one to Haskell is not of any particular importance, as it is purely a personal note to him, thanking him for some reference he made to me in a recent article in the KANSAS CITY STAR which had to do with Cuba. I wanted Miller and Mann to see the letter I have written to Perkins because I know that they are both deeply interested in the protection of U.S. interests and investments in Latin America, and they naturally understand that anything we do in Spain in the way of military or economic aid may affect very deeply our investment in Latin America, and of course not only American investments but other investments as well.

According to your plans, you should be leaving Brussels for New York by this time or should already have done so, but you have postponed your departure so often that I am sending this letter to Brussels and marking it to be forwarded to you if you have already left.
