Dear Dannie :

I am sending you herewith a copy of a letter I wrote to my friend Foster Stearns in Exeter, N.H. together with a copy of a clipping from the BOSTON HERALD, an article entitled "Truman shows that he is a socialist at heart". Both enclosures are self-explanatory. I am also sending you a copy of my letter of today to Mr. Graydon on the same subject.

I think you will agree with me that it would be wonderful if in some way this column of Smith's, and I have reference to this particular article, could be given wide publicity in the U.S. by the private electricity industry.
