Marion and I wish that we could have been with you on your birthday. Many happy returns and in good health.

I have been doing more the last few weeks than for a year. The Company has many problems and I'm trying to help as much as I can. Draper has been given this important assignment in Washington that will keep him in Washington every alternate week until about March 1.

The inauguration of the new President is on Monday Dec. 1 and there are distinguished delegation here from almost every country. Foster Dulles arrives Sunday evening and leaves Tuesday morning. John Snyder arrived last night as a guest of the Mexican Government and leaves next Tuesday. He is coming in this morning - and also for dinner this evening.

It is impossible to tell what the new administration will be like. Here in Mexico we have to wait and see - and the prospects are a bit hazy. There are many problems here, besides growing pains.

I have been remiss in writing but I have been kept on the go - too much. I'm not losing more weight but can't gain any, I am gaining a little strength but there is a definite limit on what I can do. Marion is well. Sam Katz is going to New York again next week for about 3 weeks to see his dentist and I am sure he will call you.

The rains have practically stopped but we are going to have a cold winter.
