Dear Dannie,

Just a word to tell you that if I feel as fit as I do now, next week, we plan to leave on Friday morning May 30, by Eastern Air Lines for New York. It is a direct flight from Mexico City to New York. The Board meetings of Mexlight are in Toronto from Monday June 2 to June 5. We plan to stay in New York from Friday evening May 30 to Sunday evening June 1 at the Carlyle and go by train Sunday night June 1 to Toronto.

As you know Marion's sister Louise is living in Buffalo now with her husband who works for American Car and Foundry Co. We plan to leave Toronto Thursday evening June 5 by train for Buffalo and spend a few days with them. From there we go to New York or Boston, more likely Boston first, as Edith Mustard is leaving soon for a trip to Europe. We plan to go to New York for only a few days, but if it is convenient, we would like to spend just a few days with you all at Greenwich. I was quite a burden during the last year, and especially in the last months, and I feel sure she wants to make a short trip before the hot weather comes on at home and she does want to see her family.

I'm getting stronger and have gained a few pounds. The only trouble is that I still tire so easily but we should be able to take things easily on the trip.

I had a note from Jimmy the other day and wrote him we might make this short trip. If I don't feel up to it next week, we will just cancel all our plans and hope to see you in the fall after the warm weather is over.

We should like to go to Greenwich to see you for a few hours on Saturday or Sunday of next week, but I think I shall have to stick to the hotel and take it easy.

If we do go, our plane gets to Idlewild at 5.55 pm your time, and I will call you on the phone Friday evening or Saturday morning.

Sam and Grace Katz have been in New York at the Ambassadors for several weeks and will probably stay until the end of May so we hope to see them the Saturday and Sunday we are there before we to go Toronto.

We are having cold, rainy, cloudy days both in Mexico City and Cuernavaca and it is as much pleasure as usual to spend the week ends at Cuernavaca, but we go just the same. I hope this finds you all well. I'm very happy at the thought of seeing you again soon, and hope nothing goes wrong. Marion joins in love and good wishes to you all.
