

MEMORANDUM

- 1 - Paul and Lydia GUNZBOURG received visas on October 29, 1940.
- 2 - It was impossible to give Helen Douglas a visa before the departure of the Gunzbourgs for Lisbon, because we were waiting for an Estonian number for her use. An Estonian number has since been received but Miss Douglas has proceeded to Lisbon.
- 3 - Georges and Lidia ROTVAND first registered for immigration visas on August 27, 1940, and we have no documents whatever on file concerning their cases.
- 4 - Boris ZOLOTNISKY received a visa on October 31, 1940. Jacques ZOLONITZKY has been approved but has not come in for the visa due to illness.
- 5 - Mrs. Karl A. FRANK and her family will receive visas when they present proof of their ability to obtain French 'visa de sortie' and to travel to the United States.
