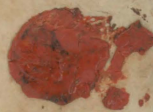


Know all by these presents that I Josiah Lewis

I know all men by These presents
That we Randal Blacksher & Philip Lewis &
Joseph David & Tho^s Murphey farmers all in the
County of Kent in Little Creek Hundred farmers
we are holden and firmly bound unto Joseph Heals
in the County of Kent afforesaid and in Duck Creek
Hundred Carpenter in the sume of Twenty four
pounds Currant and Lawfull money of Pennsylvania
To be paid to the said Joseph Heals or to his certain
Lawfull Attorney Heirs Executors Administrators
or Assigns To the which payment well and truly
to be made we do hereby bind our selves or either of us
or either of our Heirs Executors Administrators or
Assigns jointly and severally in the whole and for
the whole firmly these presents sealed with our seals
and Dated this Sixth Day of September in the year
of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred and fifty &
four Annoque Domini 1754

The condition of this obligation is such that if the
above Bounden Randal Blacksher & Philip Lewis
Joseph David & Thomas Murphey or either of them their or either
of their Heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns do well
and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said Joseph Heals
or to his certain Lawfull Attorney Heirs Executors
Administrators or Assigns just and full sume of Twelve
pounds of Like money as afforesaid with Lawfull interest
for the same and that at or before the first Day of Aprile
Next Enueing the Date here of with out fraud cover
or further Delay then this present obligation to be void and
of none effect or else to stand and remain in full force and vir-
lue sealed and Delivered
