Dear Jimmy:


I have your note of May 9th referring to the matter of Mexlight taking out some insurance for me in connection with the travel which I have to make on behalf of Mexlight. You are quite right that in view of the frequent travel, particularly by air, which I have been obliged to make since I joined the Company and as there are certain unquestioned risks involved it seems only wise and prudent that certain insurance be taken out to cover me, whether the benefit thereof would be for my widow or for the Company or both.

I have been, when time at the airport permitted, taking out insurance for the particular trip and which I have been paying myself and making no charge thereof. Of course, the insurance of which you speak in your letter is broader and covers disability and medical expenses.

I suggest that you get while you are in New York a specimen copy of one of these policies which Amitas has been taking out for its officers and employees together with a schedule of the annual premiums and we can consider this on your return as I shall undoubtedly have to do a good deal of travelling this year on Company business and particularly with respect to the reorganization plan and the long term credit it may in every way be prudent to take out a policy.
