Dear Mr. Ford,

The attached copy of letter to the United States Charge d'Affaires, Mexico City, of July 15th, I believe is self-explanatory.

Our information is that the Internal Revenue Service of the Treasury Department of the United States has had, and presently has, in the field some eight or ten teams, each composed of two agents, for the purpose of making a survey to form an estimate of the magnitude of tax evasion, if any, by United States citizens in foreign countries. We feel that this matter is of sufficient import to warrant its being called to the attention of the Chief of Mission here and this was done in the terms of the attached letter.
