I still have to thank you for your letter of July 15 written on board ship and giving me Mrs. Stresemann's address. I have not yet had an opportunity of going to Berlin since my return from Marienbad.

I have decided to sail for the States on the 4th September in the Empress of Britain, travelling via Quebec and Montreal and probably arriving in New York on the 10th September. I shall certainly look you up in Washington as I shall very much want to see you and hear your news, but I am afraid I shall not be able to stay more than one day as my visit to the States will be so short. I shall be leaving New York again, with my wife and daughter, on the 22nd September in the Queen Mary.

You will be interested to know that Dr. Brüning is coming here next Tuesday and staying till Thursday, so I shall be able to have some nice long talks with him. Moreover, he is going to America on the same boat as myself.
